

# **International Historical Events**

## Conflict and Warfare

1952: UK Tests First Atomic Bomb The United Kingdom successfully tested its first atomic weapon, codenamed Operation Hurricane, in the Montebello Islands, Western Australia, becoming the world's third nuclear power (after the US and the Soviet Union).

1935: Second Italo-Abyssinian War Begins Italian forces, under Benito Mussolini, invaded Ethiopia (then known as Abyssinia), beginning the Second Italo-Abyssinian War.

1993: Battle of Mogadishu Ends The two-day Battle of Mogadishu (often referred to as the "Black Hawk Down" incident) in Somalia concluded. The conflict involved US Army Rangers and Delta Force operators in a mission that was part of a wider UN-sanctioned humanitarian and peacekeeping effort.

**Treaties and Technology** 

1739: Treaty of Niš The Treaty of Niš was signed between the Ottoman Empire and the Russian Empire, ending the Russo-Turkish War (1735–1739).

1942: V-2 Rocket Achieves Space Flight A German V-2 rocket made the first successful flight into space (though not orbital), reaching an altitude of 85 km. This was a pivotal moment in the history of rocketry.

# **Sports-related Historical Events In India**

2010: The Commonwealth Games Commence in Delhi On October 3, 2010, the XIX Commonwealth Games officially opened in New Delhi, India. It was the first time that India hosted the Commonwealth Games and the largest international multi-sport event ever staged in the country at that time.

2023: India at the Asian Games October 3rd often falls during major continental events. For example, in 2023, the day was a significant one at the Asian Games i Hangzhou, China, where:

The Indian men's cricket team made their Asian Games debut in the quarter-finals.

Indian boxers like Lovlina Borgohain were in action, aiming for medals and securing Olympic quotas.

The day saw medal events in athletics and the start of the men's and women's Kabaddi campaigns for India.

# **Sports-related Historical Events** Internationally

1974: Frank Robinson Becomes MLB's First Black Manager On October 3, 1974, Frank Robinson signed a contract with the Cleveland Indians, making him the first African-American manager in the history of Major

League Baseball (MLB). He served as a player-manager for the team.

1951: "The Shot Heard 'Round the World" One of baseball's most famous moments occurred on October 3, 1951, when Bobby Thomson of the New York Giants hit a dramatic, walk-off three-run home run (off Ralph Branca of the Brooklyn Dodgers) in the bottom of the ninth inning to win the final game of a three-game playoff series, securing the National League pennant for the Giants. The moment is famously known as "The Shot Heard 'Round the World."

1920: American Professional Football Association (NFL) Begins Play On October 3, 1920, the American Professional Football Association (APFA), the precursor to the modern National Football League (NFL), played its first full slate of games. This event is considered the formal beginning of the organized professional football league in the United States.

1909: Ty Cobb's Triple Crown Detroit Tigers outfielder Ty Cobb secured the American League Triple Crown on this date, leading the league in batting average (.377), home runs (9), and runs batted in (107). He was the first player in modern baseball history to achieve this ru India Private Limited feat.






