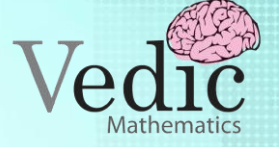

1. Cower

Kannada : ದಯನೀಯ, ಮುದುಕು, ಬಗ್ಗಿ ನಿಲ್ಲು, ಮುದುಡಿಕೊ

Hindi : डर से झुक जाना

Meaning: crouch down in fear.

Synonyms: grovel, quail, crouch

Antonyms : domineer, intimidate, alienate, answer, boast, ignore, straighten, be proud, stand up, hold your head high

Sentence:

- Before such a leader, all enemies will **cower**.
- You're not the only one **cowering** behind the sofa this series.
- He led police to a small shed, where the suspect was found **cowering** in a corner.
- An earlier shot showed the man **cowering** in a corner of the dry moat surrounding the enclosure while the tiger loomed over him.

2. Mutt

Kannada : ಮೂರ್ಖ ಅಥವಾ ಅತ್ಯಲ್ಪ ವ್ಯಕ್ತಿ

Hindi : मूर्ख

Meaning: a person regarded as stupid or incompetent.

Synonyms: fool, idiot, halfwit

Antonyms: genius, sage, intellect

Sentence:

- Do not give me orders, **mutt**.
- The **mutt** was a scruffy, but friendly dog.
- She adopted a **mutt** from the local shelter.
- I saw a **mutt** chasing a ball in the park.
- The **mutt** was a mix of several different breeds.
- The **mutt** was a great companion.

3. Reinvigorating

Kannada : ಪುನಶ್ಚೇತನಗೊಳಿಸುವುದು

Hindi : शक्ति या ऊर्जा देना

Meaning: give new energy or strength to.

Synonyms: revitalize, rejuvenate, revive

Antonyms: undermine, dampen

Sentence:

- We are fully committed to **reinvigorating** the economy of west Cornwall.
- A vital step in the process of **reinvigorating** the place of sport in school has already been taken.
- In so doing, they perform an invaluable and **reinvigorating** role in our local democracy.
- Therefore, the miner would be able to recuperate, and to return to his work **reinvigorated**.

4. Facetious

Kannada : ಮುಖಾಮುಖಿ, ತಮಾಷೆಯ, ಹಾಸ್ಯಪ್ರವೃತ್ತಿಯ

Hindi : हासकर

Meaning: treating serious issues with deliberately inappropriate humor; flippant.

Synonyms: flippant, glib, frivolous

Antonyms: serious, solemn, sober

Sentence:

- Stop being **facetious**, this is serious.
- At the risk of sounding **facetious**, we must keep dancing.
- You learn very soon never to tell a joke or make a **facetious** remark.
- I could so easily be **facetious** about this piece of news.
- It's a **facetious** question, but she answers seriously.

5. Dossier

Kannada : ದಸ್ತಾವೇಜು, ವ್ಯಕ್ತಿ ಪೂರ್ವೋತ್ತರ ದಸ್ತಾವೇಜು, ಕಾಗದ ಪತ್ರಗಳ/ದಸ್ತಾವೇಜುಗಳ/ಕಟ್ಟು

Hindi : फाइल

Meaning: a collection of documents about a particular person, event, or subject.

Synonyms: file, report, data

Antonyms : Blank slate, Empty file, Void, Ignorance, Unrecorded

Sentence:

- The company is compiling a **dossier** of evidence to back its allegations.
- We have a **dossier** on him.
- A **dossier** of complaints.
- He handed me a **dossier** containing details of the suspects.
- He has compiled a **dossier** of complaints against the police.

6. Mingling

Kannada : ಬೆರೆಯುವುದು, ಬೆರಸು, ಒಂದಾಗು, ಜೊತೆಗೂಡು, ಮಿಶ್ರಮಾಡು, ಒಟ್ಟುಗೂಡಿಸು

Hindi : घुलना मिलना

Meaning: mix or cause to mix together.

Synonyms: mix, blend, intermingle

Antonyms: parting, dissolution, split

Sentence:

- The site where the river and the ocean **mingle** their waters to form a broad estuary.
- Guests were **mingling** and chatting in the foyer.
- She became adept at **mingling** different painting styles.

7. Harried

Kannada : ಕೊಳ್ಳೆಹೊಡೆ, ಸಮಸ್ಯೆಗಳಿಂದ ತುಂಬಿದೆ, ಕಿರುಕುಳಕ್ಕೊಳಗಾದ

Hindi : परेशान

Meaning: feeling strained as a result of having demands persistently made on one; harassed.

Synonyms: bedeviled, frustrated, haggled

Antonyms: delighted, pleased, placid

Sentence:

- He was **harried** by constant bothering of his fans.
- He was **harried** by the press for most of his time in office.
- **Harried** by the hounds, the fox took refuge in a shed.
- He **harried** the east coast of England with his ships.
- The North was **harried** and the ancient church at Ripon burnt.

8. Itinerary

Kannada : ಪ್ರಯಾಣದ, ಮಾರ್ಗದರ್ಶಕಪುಸ್ತಕ

Hindi : यात्रा कार्यक्रम

Meaning: a planned route or journey.

Synonyms: voyage, journey, trip

Antonyms : immobility, inaction, indolence, stagnation, torpidity, immovability, motionlessness, rigidity, stillness, idleness

Sentence:

- Your **itinerary** includes a visit to Hawkins.
- We will be getting the tour **itinerary** by the end of this week.

- We will send you an **itinerary**.
- Editors are currently on tour, with a full **itinerary** on their website.
- Berlin is not on his **itinerary**.

9. Heady

Kannada : ತಲೆ, ಮತ್ತು ಬರಿಸುವ, ಅಮಲೇರಿಸುವ

Hindi : चतुर

Meaning: having or showing a practical cleverness or judgment

Synonyms: smart, astute, experienced

Antonyms: naive, guileless, innocent

Sentence:

- One of the **headiest** politicians around, he knows how to read the public mood at any given moment.
- The **heady** days of my youth.
- The band formed in the **heady** days of the sixties.
- She poured him a glass of a rich and **heady** Marsala.
- The perfume is a **heady** mix of floral and spicy notes.

10. Shenanigans

Kannada : ಕುಹಕ, ಕೆಡುಕು, ತೊಂದರೆ, ಹಾನಿ, ಹಾವಳಿ

Hindi : धोखाधड़ी

Meaning: secret or dishonest activity or maneuvering.
