1. Acme

Kannada : ಶ್ರೇಷ್ಠತೆ, ಶಿಖರ

Hindi : शिखर

Meaning: the highest part or point

Synonyms: pinnacle, zenith, height

Antonyms: bottom, foot, base

Sentence:

- His work is considered the **acme** of cinematic art.
- The spelling bee represents the **acme** of their parents' study-hard work ethic.
- Physics is the **acme** of scientific knowledge.
- Are neatly-kept lawns the **acme** of suburban aspiration?

2. Veracious

Kannada : ಪ್ರಾಮಾಣಿಕ, ದಿಟ ನುಡಿಯುವ, ಪ್ರಾಮಾಣಿಕವಾದ, ನಿಜಹೇಳುವ

Hindi : सत्यप्रिय

Meaning: being in the habit of telling the truth

Synonyms: honest, outspoken, truthful

Antonyms: dishonest, false, untruthful

Sentence:

- He has a reputation for being **veracious**, so people generally take his word for things.

- I am not sure that that was really quite such a good or **veracious** account of these families as we are led to suppose.
- His works generally received high acclaim from critics for their thoughtful description and **veracious** reflection of the society in the 1945 era.

3. Arcane

Kannada : ರಹಸ್ಯವಾದ

Hindi : रहस्यमय

Meaning: difficult for one of ordinary knowledge or intelligence to understand

Synonyms: esoteric, profound, recondite

Antonyms: superficial, simple, shallow

Sentence:

- This argument may seem **arcane** to those not closely involved in the world of finance.
- Here at least, the lyrics are quite clear and not concealed beneath some **arcane** reference.
- Modern conflict may be too complex for **arcane** forms of protest.
- This is not a task to be undertaken lightly: the language is convoluted and **arcane**.
- But in the **arcane** world of Commonwealth Games eligibility, nothing is simple.

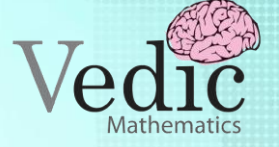

4. Eager

Kannada : ಉತ್ಸುಕ, ಉತ್ಸಾಹಿ, ಕಟಾಸೆಯುಳ್ಳ, ಅತ್ಯಾಸಕ್ತಿಯ, ಅತುರವುಳ್ಳ

Hindi : उत्सुक

Meaning: showing urgent desire or interest

Synonyms: excited, avid, enthusiastic

Antonyms: indifferent, apathetic, unenthusiastic

Sentence:

- Tom was **eager** to try out his new pair of skis.
- I was **eager** to hear what they had to say.
- What is it that makes her so **eager** to please?
- The man was **eager** to please.
- He is **eager** to please.

5. Nuisance

Kannada : ಉಪದ್ರವ, ಅನಿಷ್ಟ, ಪೀಡೆ, ಹೇಸಿಗೆ, ಪೀಡೆ

Hindi : उपद्रवी

Meaning: one who is obnoxiously annoying

Synonyms: tease, pest, annoyer

Antonyms: charmer, smoothie, comforter

Sentence:

- The dogs next door is a real **nuisance**.
- I hope you're not going to make a **nuisance** of yourself.
- It's a **nuisance** having all those people clomping through the house.

- It's a just a terrible **nuisance**.
- The children were being a **nuisance**.

6. Taverns

Kannada : ಹೋಟೆಲುಗಳು, ತಂಗುಮನೆ, ನಿಲ್ಮನೆ, ಕುಡಿವೆಡೆ, ತಂಗುವೆಡೆ, ಪಾನಗೃಹ

Hindi : सराय

Meaning: a place that provides rooms and usually a public dining room for overnight guests

Synonyms: hotels, hostels, motels

Antonyms : advantage, jump, estate car, champagne lounge, bottle stores, speakeasys, package stores, soup kitchen

Sentence:

- Gainsborough has 44 hotels, inns, and **taverns**, 9 beer houses, and 4 eating and boarding houses.
- There are no sad farewells at the local **taverns** or the corner store because there are no local taverns or corner stores.
- It was sold in a pulqueria, a **tavern**.
- Although **taverns** varied considerably in size, the victuallers were generalists, slow to build up specialist functions for their houses.

7. Janitor

Kannada : ದ್ವಾರಪಾಲಕ, ಬಾಗಿಲು ಕಾಯುವವನು, ಕಂಬಿಗ, ದಫೇದಾರ, ಗೃಹರಕ್ಷಕ

Hindi : चौकीदार

Meaning: a person who takes care of a property sometimes for an absent owner

Synonyms: custodian, caretaker, keeper

Antonyms : danger, hazard, menace, prisoner, pink-collar worker, attacker, freeholder, holder

Sentence:

- Got a job as the night **janitor** at the elementary school.
- He worked as a school **janitor**.
- I found the **janitor** in the basement and asked him to lend me his keys.
- He hospital **janitor** mopped the floor of the ward.

8. Melancholy

Kannada : ವಿಷಣ್ಣತೆ, ದುಮ್ಮಾನ, ಖೇದ, ಖಿನ್ನತೆ, ತಲ್ಲಣ, ವ್ಯಾಕುಲತೆ, ಖಿನ್ನ ಸ್ವಭಾವ, ವಿಷಣ್ಣ ಪ್ರಕೃತಿ, ಕೊರಗು, ಮಂಕುತನ

Hindi : उदासी

Meaning: causing unhappiness

Synonyms: sad, depressing, mournful

Antonyms: happy, cheery, glad

Sentence:

- The **melancholy** thought of having to say good-bye to all the friends he had made over the summer.
- She played a **melancholy** love song.
- A sense of **melancholy** pervades all his work.
- He was a serious and rather **melancholy** man.
- She was left all alone and feeling **melancholy**.

9. Vaticinate

Kannada : ಭವಿಷ್ಯ ಹೇಳು, ಪ್ರವಾದ ಮಾಡುವಿಕೆ

Hindi : भविष्यवाणी करना

Meaning: to tell of or describe beforehand

Synonyms: predict, forecast, anticipate

Antonyms: describe, report, relate

Sentence:

- He **vaticinated** a period of peace for the continent.
- If he could really **vaticinate** the course of the stock market, he'd be rich enough to own Manhattan.
- You might **vaticinate** about the next day's weather or what will happen on your favorite television show in the upcoming season.
- A magician might **vaticinate** what card you'll pull out of a deck.
- What the end might be he could not pretend to **vaticinate**.
