Synonyms: violate, profane, treat sacrilegiously

Antonyms: reverent, reverential, worshipful

### 2. Scuttled

Hindi : भागना

Meaning: run hurriedly or furtively with short quick steps.

# 3. Mollify

Kannada : ತಾಪ, ಕಾಠಿಣ್ಯ, ತಗ್ಗಿಸು, ಸಮಾಧಾನಗೊಳಿಸು, ಸಾಂತ್ರನಗೊಳಿಸು, ಕಡಮೆಗೊಳಿಸು

Hindi: शांत करना

Meaning: appease the anger or anxiety of (someone).

Synonyms: appease, placate, pacify Antonyms: anger, enrage, incense

#### Sentence:

- I tried to **mollify** her by giving her flowers.
- My feeling is that he will leave, though good results could yet mollify him.
- We'll probably just see a bunch of cosmetic amendments to mollify the rebels.

or upside down.

Synonyms: set up, upraise, put up

Antonyms: demolish, flatten

- I upended the bucket to use as a stool.
- A giant wave **upended** the surfers.
- He upended the bicycle to fix its flat tire.
- The security inspector **upended** my bag and dumped everything out.
- The genre has been credited with upending the stereotype of gaming as a sedentary activity, and promoting an active lifestyle.
- The bicycle lay **upended** in a ditch.

- allies The threatened economic reprisals against the invading country.
- The hostages were taken in **reprisal** for the bombing.
