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1. Procure

Kannada : ಸಂಪಾದಿಸು, ಗಳಿಸು, ಉಂಟುಮಾಡು

Hindi : प्राप्त करना

Meaning: obtain (something), especially with care or effort.

Synonyms: obtain, acquire, get

Antonyms: forfeit, lose, give away

Sentence:

- Can you **procure** some tickets for me?
- They **procure** some food for us.
- I had managed to **procure** a bottle of sherry.
- Would you be able to **procure** medical supplies for us?
- He persuaded a friend to **procure** him a ticket.

2. Amend

Kannada : ತಿದ್ದುಪಡಿ ಮಾಡಿ, ತಪ್ಪುತಿದ್ದು, ತಪ್ಪುಸರಿಪಡಿಸು

Hindi : संशोधन

Meaning: make minor changes in (a text) in order to make it fairer, more accurate, or more up-to-date.

Synonyms: revise, alter, modify

Antonyms: worsen, disfigure, injure

Sentence:

- The rule was **amended** to apply only to non-members.

- **Amend** your soil with peat moss or compost.
- It may be desirable to **amend** the soil with sand or peat.
- The solicitor had to **amend** the document.

3. Ailing

Kannada : ಅಸ್ವಸ್ಥ, ಕಾಯಿಲೆಯ

Hindi : बीमार

Meaning: in poor health.

Synonyms: ill, unwell, sick

Antonyms: healthy, well, fit

Sentence:

- I went to see my **ailing** mother.
- What's **ailing** you?
- Monday was a bit of a drama with our poor, **ailing** pooch, Fred.
- She looked after her **ailing** mother for many years.
- Her experiences set her thinking about new ways to fix our **ailing** health service.

4. Snug

Kannada : ಹಿತವಾದ, ಅನುಕೂಲವಾಗಿರುವ, ಹಿತವಾಗಿರುವ, ಅಚ್ಚುಕಟ್ಟಾಗಿರುವ

Hindi : आरामदायक

Meaning: comfortable, warm, and cozy; well protected from the weather or cold.





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Synonyms: comfortable, warm, cheerful

Antonyms: uncomfortable, unpleasant, harsh

Sentence:

- They lay **snug** and warm amid the blankets.
- A well-shaped hood for a **snug** fit.
- She was safe and **snug** in Ruth's arms.
- We're very **snug** in here now.
- These new jeans are rather **snug**.

5. Melee

Kannada : ಗಲಿಬಿಲಿ, ದೊಂಬಿ ಹೋರಾಟ

Hindi : हाथापाई

Meaning: a confused fight, skirmish, or scuffle.

Synonyms: tumult, disturbance, rumpus

Antonyms: truce, peace

Sentence:

- Several people were hurt in the **melee**.
- The **melee** of people that were always thronging the streets.
- Several people were hurt in the **melee**.
- He described two fights within the extended **melee** outside the nightclub.

6. Strangle

Kannada : ಕತ್ತು ಹಿಸುಕು, ಕುತ್ತಿಗೆ ಹಿಸುಕು, ಅದಮಿ ಹಾಕು, ಕತ್ತು ಹಿಸುಕಿ ಕೊಲ್ಲು, ಕೊರಳು ಹಿಸುಕು

Hindi : गला घोटना

Meaning: squeeze or constrict the neck of (a person or animal), especially so as to cause death.

Synonyms: throttle, choke, garrotte

Antonyms: restore, resuscitate, revive

Sentence:

- The victim was **strangled** with a scarf.
- Business is telling us that an assembly would **strangle** growth.
- They allowed bureaucracy to **strangle** initiative

7. Arbitration

Kannada : ಮಧ್ಯಸ್ಥಿಕೆ

Hindi : पंचफैसला

Meaning: the use of an arbitrator to settle a dispute.

Synonyms: adjudication, negotiation, conciliation

Antonyms : disagreement, indecision

Sentence:

- Tayside Regional Council called for **arbitration** to settle the dispute.
- Our case may go to **arbitration**.
- The union is now calling for binding **arbitration** to settle the dispute.
- Claims can be settled via mutual consent, by **arbitration** or by a court award.
- The dispute went to **arbitration**.





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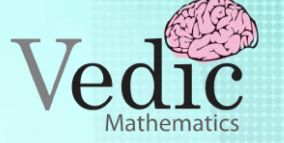
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8. Evict

Kannada : ಹೊರಹಾಕು, ಓಡಿಸಿಬಿಡು, ಹೊರಡಿಸು,

Hindi : बेदखल करना

Meaning: expel (someone) from a property, especially with the support of the law.

Synonyms: expel, eject, remove

Antonyms: take in, welcome, admit

Sentence:

- He had court orders to **evict** the trespassers from three camps.
- The order enabled the police to **evict** any tenants and board up the property.
- York council has demonstrated its resolve to **evict** nuisance tenants.

9. Pity

Kannada : ಕರುಣೆ, ಅನುಕಂಪ, ಕನಿಕರ

Hindi : दया

Meaning: the feeling of sorrow and compassion caused by the suffering and misfortunes of others.

Synonyms: compassion, commiseration, condolence

Antonyms: inhumanity, mercilessness, cruelty

Sentence:

- Her voice was full of **pity**.
- It's a **pity** that you have to leave.

- What a **pity** we can't be friends.
- He felt no **pity** for them.
- Her voice was full of **pity**.

10. Eulogize

Kannada : ಸ್ತುತಿಸಿ, ಹೊಗಳು

Hindi : प्रशंसा करना

Meaning: praise highly in speech or writing.

Synonyms: Applaud, honour, glorify

Antonyms: blame, criticize, condemn

Sentence:

- He was **eulogized** at his funeral as a great actor and a good friend.
- He mourned her for the rest of his days, and wrote poems **eulogizing** her.
- He would often **eulogize** the soldier, and never refused a request to speak at any funeral.
