

1. Tacit

Kannada : ಮೌನವಾಗಿ, ಸೂಚಿತ, ಅಧ್ಯಾಹೃತ, ಧ್ವನಿತ

Hindi : समझना

Meaning: understood or implied without being stated.

Synonyms: implied, implicit, understood

Antonyms: explicit, express, obvious

Sentence:

- The deal had the **tacit** approval of the President.
- Your silence may be taken to mean **tacit** agreement.
- Even in conservative Hong Kong, there was a sense of **tacit** support and envy.
- The Promotion of Volunteering Bill has even gained the **tacit** support of the government.
- It is submitted that this represented no more than a **tacit** understanding between staff members.

2. Mishmash

Kannada : ಕಲಬೆರಕೆ, ಗೊಂದಲಮಯ ಅವ್ಯವಸ್ಥೆ

Hindi : मिश्रण

Meaning: an unorganized collection or mixture of various things

Synonyms: jumble, medley, clutter

Antonyms : Order, System, Arrangement, Organization, Structure, Harmony,

Method, Uniformity, Neatness, Consistency

Sentence:

- The painting was just a **mishmash** of colors and abstract shapes as far as we could tell.
- Underlying the idea of the multitude is a **mishmash** of confused claims.
- A **mishmash** of outmoded ideas.

3. Fad

Kannada : ಒಲವು, ಚಟ, ಗೀಳು

Hindi : उन्माद

Meaning: a practice or interest that is very popular for a short time

Synonyms: craze, trend, vogue

Antonyms: standard, classic

Sentence:

- His interest in photography is only a passing **fad**.
- It's just a little **fad** of hers.
- It's just a passing **fad**.
- To me, fashion is what looks good, not the latest craze or **fad**.
- I'm not one of those people who follows **fad** diets.

4. Bandwagon

Kannada : ಅಂಧಾನುಕರಣೆ ಅಥವಾ ಸಾಮೂಹಿಕ ಬೆಂಬಲದಿಂದ ಆಕರ್ಷಿಸುವ ಒಂದು ಪಕ್ಷ, ಚಳುವಳಿ ಅಥವಾ ಕಾರಣ

Hindi : अभियान

Meaning: a series of activities undertaken to achieve a goal

Synonyms: campaign, movement, crusade

Antonyms : Opposition, Dissent, Resistance, Rebellion, Defiance, Individualism, Nonconformity, Independence, Disagreement, Contradiction

Sentence:

- They tried to get everyone on the **bandwagon** about forming a neighborhood cleanup.
- He says a bit in his defence and then carries on on his **bandwagon**.
- The colourful **bandwagon** was later purchased for use in circus parades.
- Concerns over the risk posed by this emerging technology threaten to derail the **bandwagon**.
- Any spectacle surrounding the Tyson **bandwagon** tends to display only the awesome power of money.

5. Marring

Kannada : ಹಾಳುಮಾಡುವುದು, ಕೆಡಿಸುವುದು, ದೂಷಿಸುವುದು, ಅಥವಾ ಹಾನಿ ಮಾಡುವುದು

Hindi : बिगाड़ना

Meaning: to affect slightly with something morally bad or undesirable

Synonyms: tainting, spoiling, staining

Antonyms: cleansing, purifying

Sentence:

- One scabbed sheep will **mar** a whole flock.
- The set was supremely simple, only a keyhole and a switch **marring** its exterior.
- They are **marring** it, not in a major particular, but in a small matter, but which is still one of very great psychological importance.
- It is not only a question of **marring** the landscape.

6. Strewn

Kannada : ಹರಡಿಕೊಂಡಿದೆ, ಚೆಲ್ಲಾಪಿಲ್ಲಿಯಾಗಿ ಬಿದ್ದಿರುವ, ಚದುರಿರುವ, ಹರಡಿರುವ, ಅಥವಾ ಎರಚಿರುವ

Hindi : बिखेरना

Meaning: to cover by or as if by scattering something over or on

Synonyms: spray, sprinkle, scatter

Antonyms : Collected, Gathered, Assembled, Organized, Arranged, Neat, Ordered, Consolidated, Packed, Clustered

Sentence:

- Sidewalks were **strewn** with trash left by the parade watchers.
- The wind had **strewn** leaves all over the lawn.

7. Revocation

Kannada : ರದ್ದತಿ, ಹಿಂತೆಗೆದುಕೊಳ್ಳುವಿಕೆ, ಅಥವಾ ವಾಪಸಾತಿ

Hindi : रद्दकरण

Meaning: the official cancellation of a decree, decision, or promise.

Synonyms: cancellation, repeal, abandonment

Antonyms: continuation, beginning, initiation

Sentence:

- The government announced its **revocation** of 311 banking licences.
- For those who break the law, **revocation** of their liquor licence may result.
- The community rallied to save its land from **revocation**.
- The king's persecutions culminated in the **revocation** of the edict in 1685.
- This **revocation** can be carried either online or by subsequently published DVDs.

8. Highfalutin

Kannada : ವಾಗಾಡಂಬರ, ಶಬ್ದಾಡಂಬರ, ಹೆಮ್ಮೆಯ, ಆಡಂಬರದ, ಅತಿಶಯೋಕ್ತಿಯ ಅಥವಾ ಮಿಮಿಕರ

Hindi : भव्य

Meaning: (especially of speech, writing, or ideas) pompous or pretentious.

Synonyms: pretentious, grandiose, rhetorical

Antonyms: modest, humble, lowly

Sentence:

- It is a mistake to use **highfalutin** language when you advertise to uneducated people.
- His **highfalutin** accent made him sound arrogant.
- They dismissed the plan as a **highfalutin** idea that wouldn't work in practice.

9. Ornate

Kannada : ಅಲಂಕೃತ, ವಿಪುಲವಾಗಿ ಅಲಂಕರಿಸಿದ, ಸುಂದರ, ಅಥವಾ ಅದ್ಭುತವಾಗಿ ಅಲಂಕರಿಸಲ್ಪಟ್ಟಿದೆ

Hindi : सरूप

Meaning: made in an intricate shape or decorated with complex patterns.

Synonyms: decorated, embellished, adorned

Antonyms: plain, unadorned

Meaning: how surprising, doubtful, or unbelievable

Synonyms: oh, what

Antonyms : Praise, Approval, Commendation, Admiration, Applause, Appreciation, Compliment, Endorsement

Sentence:

- **Fie!** you expect me to believe that sorry excuse?
- **Fie!** You expect me to believe that sorry excuse?
- **Fie**, for shame!
- **Fie** on those who deceive others!
