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1. Exult

Kannada : ಉಲ್ಲಾಸ, ಹಿಗ್ಗು, ಉಬ್ಬು, ಬೀಗು

Hindi : प्रसन्न होना

Meaning: To feel or express joy or triumph.

Synonyms: delight, joy, glory

Antonyms: regret, weep, grieve

Sentence:

- She **exulted** in her new discovery.
- They **exulted** at their victory.
- **exult** over Campaigners exulted over the ruling announced yesterday.
- **exult** in She seems to exult in her power.

2. Placate

Kannada : ಸಮಾಧಾನಪಡಿಸು, ಶಾಂತಗೊಳಿಸು, ಸಂತೈಸು

Hindi : शांत करना

Meaning: To lessen the anger or agitation of.

Synonyms: appease, soothe, mollify

Antonyms: anger, infuriate, inflame

Sentence:

- He smiled, trying to **placate** me.
- This doesn't **placate** anyone or calm things down or keep order.
- He has tried to **placate** his critics within the party.
- Take a saucer of milk to **placate** him and you might just escape unscathed.

- It adopts no postures of phoney charms to **placate** its visitors.

3. Scintillate

Kannada : ಥಳಥಳಿಸು, ಮಿನುಗು, ಚಟಾಕಿ ಹಾರಿಸು

Hindi : चमकना

Meaning: To give off sparks.

Synonyms: glow, spark, shine

Antonyms: dull, dark, dim

Sentence:

- You were **scintillating** on TV last night.
- The sleek boat seemed to **scintillate** with a dark blue light.
- The script doesn't break new ground, or **scintillate** with New Yorker wit.

4. Miser

Kannada : ಜಿಪುಣ, ಜುಗ್ಗು

Hindi : कंजूस

Meaning: A mean grasping person who is usually stingy with money.

Synonyms: hunk, skinflint, tightwad

Antonyms: spendthrift, spender, prodigal

Sentence:

- The money the **miser** hoards will do him no good.
- Why don't you buy me a drink for a change, you old **miser**!
- A typical **miser**, he hid his money in the house in various places.





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5. Ignominy

Kannada : ಅವಮಾನ, ಅಪಮಾನ, ಅಪಖ್ಯಾತಿ, ಕುಖ್ಯಾತಿ, ಅಪಕೀರ್ತಿ

Hindi : बदनामी

Meaning: The state of having lost the esteem of others.

Synonyms: disgrace, shame, humiliation

Antonyms: respect, esteem, honor

Sentence:

- He feared the **ignominy** of being exposed as a spy.
- That should be enough to pile **ignominy** upon him.
- Our hockey boys seem to be collapsing in **ignominy**, though.
- Imagine the shame, the **ignominy**, the dire social consequences.
- The **ignominy** of being imprisoned.

6. Quiescence

Kannada : ಶಾಂತತೆ, ಜಡತ್ವ, ನಿಶ್ಚಲತೆ

Hindi : शांति

Meaning: A state of temporary inactivity.

Synonyms: coma, suspense, rest

Antonyms: continuation, continuance, renewal

Sentence:

- But fiery activism or evasive **quiescence** are the poles of choice, and the poles are notoriously uninhabitable.

- Incomprehensible and invisible, eternal and unbegotten, he was throughout endless ages in serenity and **quiescence**.
- They probably represent remnants of microbial mats that developed on the seafloor during the **quiescence** periods of submarine hydrothermal activity.

7. Tractable

Kannada : ಟ್ರ್ಯಾಕ್ ಮಾಡಬಹುದಾದ, ಸುಲಭ ನಿರ್ವಹಿಸಬಹುದಾದ, ತಿದ್ದಬಲ್ಲ, ಸಾವಗಿಸಬಲ್ಲ, ಮಾರ್ಪಡಿಸಬಲ್ಲ

Hindi : अपेक्षा

Meaning: Readily giving in to the command or authority of another.

Synonyms: obedient, docile, compliant

Antonyms: intractable, refractory, recalcitrant

Sentence:

- The problem turned out to be rather less **tractable** than I had expected.
- She has always been **tractable** and obedient, even as a child.
- And that under-powered engine is pleasingly **tractable** on the slippery stuff.
- The pair had to adjust their probabilistic model to make the calculations more **tractable**.





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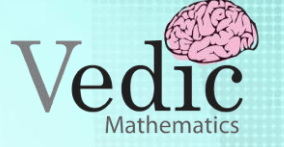
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- People are inclined to take advantage of your sympathetic, **tractable** nature.

8. Derisive

Kannada : ಅಪಹಾಸ್ಯ, ಅಣಕಿಸುವ

Hindi : व्यंगपूर्ण

Meaning: So foolish or pointless as to be worthy of scornful laughter.

Synonyms: ridiculous, absurd, silly

Antonyms: serious, solemn, earnest

Sentence:

- He snorted **derisive** laughter.
- He gave a harsh, **derisive** laugh.
- Her speech drew **derisive** comments from the audience.
- His defence of the government's record on healthcare was greeted with **derisive** laughter.
- Answers can be serious, solemn, pithy, witty, biting, **derisive**, belittling.

9. Corroborate

Kannada : ದೃಢೀಕರಿಸಿ, ವಿಧಿಯುಕ್ತವಾಗಿ ದೃಢೀಕರಿಸು

Hindi : पुष्ट करना

Meaning: To give evidence or testimony to the truth or factualness of.

Synonyms: confirm, verify, argue

Antonyms: refute, disprove, rebut

Sentence:

- The witnesses **corroborated** the policeman's testimony.
- There was no evidence to **corroborate** his story.
- A witness was able to **corroborate** his statement.
- The figures **corroborate** earlier findings.

10. Venerate

Kannada : ಪೂಜಿಸು, ಗೌರವಿಸು, ಸಂಭಾವಿಸು

Hindi : आदर करना

Meaning: To offer honor or respect to (someone) as a divine power.

Synonyms: reverence, honor, admire

Antonyms: reverence, honor, admire

Sentence:

- My father **venerated** General Eisenhower.
- Thousands of people come to the cathedral to **venerate** the relics of the saint.
- They **venerate** the spirits of their ancestors.
