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1. Eminence

Kannada : ಶ್ರೇಷ್ಠತೆ, ತಿಟ್ಟು, ದಿಣ್ಣೆ, ಮೇಡು, ಗೌರವ, ಕಿರೀಟ, ಹೆಗ್ಗಲಿಕೆ, ಉನ್ನತಿ, ಹಿರಿಮೆ, ಉತ್ಕರ್ಷ, ಗುರುತ್ವ, ಖ್ಯಾತಿ

Hindi : श्रेष्ठता

Meaning: fame or recognized superiority, especially within a particular sphere or profession.

Synonyms: renown, pre-eminence, notability

Antonyms: inferiority, mediocrity, obscureness

Sentence:

- Beveridge was a man of great **eminence**.
- She is also renowned for the **eminence** of her contacts.
- From modest roots, his rise to **eminence** was all the more remarkable.
- A swelling on the lower surface of the brain termed the median **eminence**.
- The honorary position is seen as a reward for professional **eminence** in the field.

2. Proscription

Kannada : ನಿಷೇಧ, ತಡೆಹಾಕು, ಹೊರಹಾಕು, ನಿಷೇಧಿಸು, ಹೊರಗಟ್ಟು, ಬಹಿಷ್ಕರಿಸು, ಗಡೀಪಾರು ಮಾಡು, ದೇಶಭ್ರಷ್ಟಗೊಳಿಸು

Hindi : बहिष्कार

Meaning: the action of forbidding something; banning.

Synonyms: prohibition, prohibiting, forbidding

Antonyms: allowance, permission, sufferance

Sentence:

- The **proscription** against bicycles and skateboards is intended to make the plaza a more pedestrian-friendly place.
- However, what would her **proscription** there have been?
- The **proscription** of the party after the 1715 Rebellion.
- The offences under sections 11 to 13 are all direct consequences of **proscription**.

3. Fissiparous

Kannada : ಸಿಡಿದು ಹರಡುವ

Hindi : विभाजित

Meaning: inclined to cause or undergo division into separate parts or groups.

Synonyms: division, partition, separation

Antonyms: assemblage, association

Sentence:

- High-quality, **fissiparous** yeast can resist high temperature, it is available





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for summer production, and low-down energy cost.

- Already **fissiparous**, the home side seemed broken. British society may be diverse but it is not fissiparous.
- Management of his **fissiparous**, some would say ungovernable, party will be not the least of his challenges.
- Musical taste is fashionable and **fissiparous**.

4. Subservient

Kannada : ಅಧೀನ, ಸಾಧನವಾದ, ಸಾಧಕವಾದ, ಉಪಕರಣವಾದ, ತಲೆಬಾಗುವ, ಕೀಳ್ಮೆಡಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳುವ, ಹಲ್ಲುಗಿರಿಯುವ, ಕೈಕೆಳಗಿನ, ಅತಿನಮ್ರ

Hindi : अधीन

Meaning: prepared to obey others unquestioningly.

Synonyms: submissive, deferential, acquiescent

Antonyms: disrespectful, impolite, impudent

Sentence:

- She was **subservient** to her parents.
- He expected her career to become **subservient** to his.
- I always considered them to be too **subservient**.

- The government's **subservient** attitude to the United States was criticized online.

5. Fortuitous

Kannada : ಆಕಸ್ಮಿಕ, ಅನುದ್ಧಿಷ್ಟ, ಅಸಂಕಲ್ಪಿತ, ಅದೃಷ್ಟವಶವಾದ, ಅನಿರೀಕ್ಷಿತವಾದ

Hindi : आकस्मिक

Meaning: happening by accident or chance rather than design.

Synonyms: chance, unexpected, unanticipated

Antonyms: hapless, intentional, planned

Sentence:

- The similarity between the paintings may not be simply **fortuitous**.
- The ball went into the goal by a **fortuitous** ricochet.
- The resemblance between the paintings may not be simply **fortuitous**.
- By a **fortuitous** coincidence, it involves some real handcuffs.
- It probably arose from the accidental but **fortuitous** fermentation of grapes from wild vines.





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6. Discretion

Kannada : ವಿವೇಚನೆ, ಎಚ್ಚರಿಕೆಯ, ವಿವೇಕ, ತಿಳಿವು, ಕಣ್ಣರಿ, ಕಣ್ಮಲೆ, ಸ್ವವಿವೇಚನೆ, ಸ್ವಂತ ವಿವೇಚನೆ, ಯುಕ್ತಾಯುಕ್ತತೆ

Hindi : विवेक

Meaning: the quality of behaving or speaking in such a way as to avoid causing offense or revealing private information.

Synonyms: circumspection, caution, carefulness

Antonyms: imprudence, indiscretion

Sentence:

- You must show **discretion** in choosing your friend.
- I'll be the soul of **discretion**.
- I know I can trust your **discretion**.
- She knew she could rely on his **discretion**.
- Paul is renowned for his **discretion**, for keeping his counsel as well as his word.

7. Deplorable

Kannada : ಶೋಚನೀಯ

Hindi : खेदजनक

Meaning: deserving strong condemnation.

Synonyms: disgraceful, shameful, dishonorable

Antonyms: admirable, commendable, creditable

Sentence:

- We will not tolerate such **deplorable** behavior in a house of worship.
- 'I think it is a **deplorable** state of affairs,' he told the town council.
- The building was in a **deplorable** state.
- His shocking behaviour showed a **deplorable** lack of good manners.
- This was **deplorable** conduct for a public figure.

8. Prattling

Kannada : ಹರಟು, ಸೊರಹು, ಪದರಾಡು, ಬಡಬಡಿಸು, ಉಲಿಹೊರಡಿಸು, ಗೊಡ್ಡು ಹರಟೆ ಹರಟು, ಸುಮ್ಮನೆ ಕೆಲಸಕ್ಕೆ ಬಾರದ ಮಾತನಾಡು, ತೊದಲು ನುಡಿ

Hindi : बकवास

Meaning: talk at length in a foolish or inconsequential way.

Synonyms: chatter, babble, prate

Antonyms: articulating, enunciating

Sentence:

- The villagers are **prattling** on about the village gossip.
- We'd better stop **prattling** and start work!
- I spent the first part of the session **prattling** on about this week's dramas.





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- She is still powerful, **prattling** and perfectly potty but there is something missing.

9. Impermanence

Kannada : ಅಶಾಶ್ವತತೆ, ಅನಿತ್ಯ, ಅಧ್ರುವ, ಶಾಶ್ವತವಲ್ಲದ

Hindi : अनस्थिरता

Meaning: the state or fact of lasting for only a limited period of time.

Synonyms: ephemerality, evanescence, fleetingness

Antonyms: endurance, permanence, permanency

Sentence:

- Change, **impermanence** is characteristic of life.
- She says that her paintings represent the **impermanence** of everything.
- Life is often shaped by **impermanence** and solitude.
- The **impermanence** of wood is in contrast to the permanence of stone.

10. Loquacious

Kannada : ವಾಚಾಳಿಯಾದ, ಅತಿಯಾಗಿ ಮಾತಾಡುವ, ಹರಟೆಮಲ್ಲ, ಕಡುಹರಟುವ

Hindi : बातूनी

Meaning: tending to talk a great deal; talkative.

Synonyms: talkative, garrulous, voluble

Antonyms: closemouthed, laconic, quiet

Sentence:

- Davis was never **loquacious** on the subject of his progeny.
- I cannot tell whether he recognized me, but that night he was voluble, almost **loquacious**.
- Never **loquacious**, Sarah was now totally lost for words.
- Mainstream politicians in Holland have found it difficult to respond to the **loquacious** professor.
- They are intensely literate and endlessly **loquacious**.
