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### 1. Ascension

**Kannada :** ಆರೋಹಣ, ಏರಿಕೆ

**Hindi :** अधिरोहण

**Meaning:** the act of rising to an important position or a higher level.

**Synonyms:** ascent, climb, rise

**Antonyms:** descent, downfall, downgrade

**Sentence:**

- His **ascension** to the ranks of pop star.
- His **ascension** to the presidency.
- The 22 sections present the Resurrection and **Ascension** of Jesus in a vigorously dramatic way.

### 2. Fretting

**Kannada :** ಹತಾಶೆ, ರೇಗು, ಸಿಡಿಮಿಡಿಗೊಳ್ಳು, ದೊರಗಾಗು, ಸವೆದುಹೋಗು, ತಳಮಳಗೊಳ್ಳು, ದುಗುಡಗೊಳ್ಳು

**Hindi :** बेचैन रहना

**Meaning:** be constantly or visibly worried or anxious.

**Synonyms:** worry, be anxious, feel uneasy

**Antonyms:** calm, relaxed, confident

**Sentence:**

- What are you **fretting** about?
- There's no point in **fretting** needlessly about the future.
- 'I was **fretting** about telling my parents,' he recalls.

- She was **fretting** over the arrangements for the wedding.
- Policyholders must be **fretting** themselves witless over what to do next.

### 3. Obstreperous

**Kannada :** ಅಡ್ಡಿಪಡಿಸುವ, ಗದ್ದಲ, ದೊಂಬಿ ಮಾಡುವ, ಗಲಾಟೆಯ, ಹತೋಟಿಗೆ ಸಿಗದ, ದೊಂಬಿ ಮಾಡುವ, ಹತೋಟಿಗೆ ಬರದ, ರಂಪಮಾಡುವ

**Hindi :** प्रचंड

**Meaning:** noisy and difficult to control.

**Synonyms:** unruly, unmanageable, undisciplined

**Antonyms:** calm, hushed, subdued

**Sentence:**

- He becomes **obstreperous** when he's had a few drinks.
- The **obstreperous** emails in question focus on Norway's economic relationship with the European Union.
- In my experience, Lefschetz was both **obstreperous** and enthusiastic - about research in mathematics.

### 4. Parley

**Kannada :** ಸಂಭಾಷಣೆ, ಸಂಧಾನ ಮಾತುಕತೆ, ಸಂಧಾನ ಸಭೆ, ಚರ್ಚಾಗೋಷ್ಠಿ, ಸಂಧಿ ಮಾತುಕತೆ ನಡೆಸು, ಒಪ್ಪಂದದ ಷರತ್ತುಗಳನ್ನು ಚರ್ಚಿಸು





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**Hindi :** बातचीत

**Meaning:** a conference between opposing sides in a dispute, especially a discussion of terms for an armistice.

**Synonyms:** negotiation, talk, meeting

**Antonyms :** inactivity, dissuade, fail, buy

**Sentence:**

- The governor was forced to **parley** with the rebels.
- A **parley** is in progress and the invaders may withdraw.
- They disagreed over whether to **parley** with the enemy.

### 5. Vapid

**Kannada :** ಸಪ್ಪೆಯಾದ, ರುಚಿಯಿಲ್ಲದ, ನೀರಸ, ಮಂಕು, ನಿರ್ಜೀವ, ಮದಡು, ಕಂಪಿಲ್ಲದ

**Hindi :** नीरस

**Meaning:** offering nothing that is stimulating or challenging.

**Synonyms:** insipid, uninspired, tepid

**Antonyms:** amazing, astonishing, astounding

**Sentence:**

- The **vapid** conversation bored her.
- The whole thing would be hilarious if it wasn't so **vapid**.
- The **vapid** storylines and woeful acting just leave me cold.

- This bland collection of **vapid** songs and empty sentiments sounds exactly as you would expect.
- Wilson's interpretations of her work, however, are often **vapid**.

### 6. Boulevard

**Kannada :** ಸಾಲುಮರಗಳ ವಿಶಾಲ

ರಾಜಮಾರ್ಗ, ಸಾಲುಮರ ರಸ್ತೆ

**Hindi :** मार्ग

**Meaning:** a wide street in a town or city, typically one lined with trees.

**Synonyms:** avenue, street, road

**Antonyms :** blockade, roadblock, closure, barrier, barricade, bulwark

**Sentence:**

- They replaced the narrow streets with wide **boulevard**.
- The band is playing on the **boulevard** and crowds are in holiday mood.
- This is a load of old **boulevards**.
- The square and a huge **boulevard** leading up to it had become a massive campsite.
- For one day only it had been transformed into a gigantic city **boulevard**.





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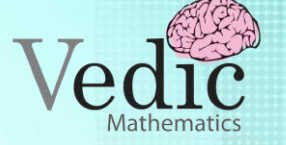
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### 7. Furtively

**Kannada :** ಛಲದಿಂದ, ಕಳ್ಳತನದ, ರಹಸ್ಯವಾದ, ರಕ್ತಿನ, ಗುಟ್ಟಾದ, ಮರೆಮಾಡಿದ, ಮುಚ್ಚುಮರೆಯ, ಕಣ್ಣು ಮರೆಸುವ, ಒಳಗೊಳಗೇ ನಡೆಸಿದ

**Hindi :** चोरी से

**Meaning:** in a way that attempts to avoid notice or attention; secretly.

**Synonyms:** secretly, sneakily, stealthily

**Antonyms:** openly, publicly

**Sentence:**

- She opened the door and looked **furtively** down the hall.
- Marion was **furtively** scanning the room to make sure she was noticed.
- We ducked **furtively** into the pub.
- I **furtively** glanced over at my father to see his reaction.
- They were whispering **furtively** to one another.

### 8. Stolid

**Kannada :** ಮಂದ, ಜಡ, ಪಸಿಯಿಸಲಾಗದ, ತಲ್ಲಣಗೊಳ್ಳದ, ಚಟುವಟಿಕೆಯಿಲ್ಲದ, ಭಾವರಹಿತ, ಭಾವೋದ್ರೇಕಶೂನ್ಯ

**Hindi :** सुस्त

**Meaning:** (of a person) calm, dependable, and showing little emotion or animation.

**Synonyms:** impassive, phlegmatic, unemotional

**Antonyms:** demonstrative, emotional, fervent

**Sentence:**

- He's a very **stolid**, serious man.
- Holmes shares rooms with the **stolid** Dr Watson.
- There is scant enthusiasm for a real leader; they seem **stolid**, harrumphing about white papers.
- A **stolid** bourgeois gent.
- She evinces a **stolid** seriousness way beyond her youthful appearance.

### 9. Obliteration

**Kannada :** ನಿರ್ಮೂಲನೆ, ಅಳಿಸಿ ಬಿಡುವುದು, ತೊಡೆದು ಹಾಕುವುದು, ಉಜ್ಜಿಹಾಕು, ಹುಟ್ಟಡಗಿಸು, ನಾಶಮಾಡು, ಒರಸಿಬಿಡು, ನಿರ್ನಾಮಗೊಳಿಸು

**Hindi :** विस्मृति

**Meaning:** the action or fact of obliterating or being obliterated; total destruction.

**Synonyms:** eradication, erasing, erasure

**Antonyms:** raising, regeneracy, refurbishment

**Sentence:**

- The result of these invasions was the near **obliteration** of ancient Egypt.
- The war resulted in the **obliteration** of hundreds of villages.







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- The reef faces **obliteration** in the near future.
- These farmers are seeing the complete **obliteration** of everything they've known.
- A terrible loneliness resulted from the **obliteration** of her short-term memories.

### 10. Exertion

**Kannada :** ಶ್ರಮ, ಪರಿಶ್ರಮ, ಧಾವತಿ, ಪ್ರಯತ್ನ,  
ಪ್ರಯೋಗ, ದುಡಿತ, ಶ್ರಮದಾಯಕ ಬಳಕೆ

**Hindi :** तनाव

**Meaning:** physical or mental effort.

**Synonyms:** strain, struggle, toil

**Antonyms:** struggle, toil

**Sentence:**

- A person with nephritis must avoid all **exertion**.
- I was panting with **exertion** by the end of the race.
- She was panting with the **exertion**.
- With meditation a lot of **exertion** is necessary, but it cannot be forced.
- The **exertion** of influence on the politician got the desired result.



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
