1. Apathetic

Kannada : ನಿರಾಸಕ್ತಿ, ಭಾವಶೂನ್ಯ, ಉದ್ವೇಗರಹಿತ

Hindi : उदासीन

Meaning: showing or feeling no interest, enthusiasm, or concern.

Synonyms: uninterested, indifferent, unconcerned

Antonyms: interested, conscientious, concerned

Sentence:

- I realised I was becoming increasingly depressed and **apathetic**.
- His bout of flu left him feeling tired and **apathetic**.
- Her friend seemed so **apathetic** and listless she wanted to shake her.
- There was an **apathetic** response to our appeal.

2. Frazzle

Kannada : ಸುಸ್ತು ಅಥವಾ ಹದಗೆಟ್ಟ ಸ್ಥಿತಿ

Hindi : थकी हुई अवस्था

Meaning: the state of being completely exhausted

Synonyms: exhaustion, fatigue, lethargy

Antonyms: refreshment, energy, rejuvenation

Sentence:

- The meeting left me feeling completely **frazzled**.

- He's a clever player who knows how to **frazzle** his opponents.
- Craig spends a lot of time getting high and looking **frazzled** and that's about all Wolff has to play.
- Don't let a few pest woes **frazzle** you and draw your attention from the beauty and peace.

3. Dwindling

Kannada : ಕ್ಷೀಣಿಸುತ್ತಿದೆ, ನಶಿಸುತ್ತಿರುವ ಅಥವಾ ಕುಗ್ಗಿಸುತ್ತಿರುವ

Hindi : कम होना

Meaning: gradually diminishing in size, amount, or strength.

Synonyms: decreasing, diminishing, subsiding

Antonyms: increasing, growing, rising

Sentence:

- The elephant population is **dwindling**.
- He said the farm's workforce was **dwindling**, with only four full-time employees.
- After six days, hope was **dwindling** that anyone else would be found alive.
- Support for the party is **dwindling**.
- They were trying to save their rapidly **dwindling** water supplies.

4. Teed off

Kannada : ಕೋಪ, ಕಿರಿಕಿರಿ



Hindi : गुस्सा होना

Meaning: feeling or showing anger

Synonyms: ballistic, angry, infuriated

Antonyms: pleased, accepting, delighted

Sentence:

- He **teed off** on the Labour Government policies.
- The boss was really **teed off** about the lost client, so we decided to avoid him for the rest of the day.
- The rude comment really **teed him off**.
- I was **teed off** because the flight was delayed for hours.
- She was very **teed off** when she learned he had been spreading rumors about her.

5. Armament

Kannada : ಶಸ್ತ್ರಾಸ್ತ್ರ, ಯುದ್ಧಸನ್ನದ ಸೈನ್ಯ

Hindi : अस्त्र – शस्त्र

Meaning: military weapons and equipment.

Synonyms: weaponry, firearms, ordnance

Antonyms : Disarmament, Demilitarization, Pacification, Peacekeeping, Neutralization

Sentence:

- The unit has insufficient **armament** with which to do battle.
- They brought up more reinforcements and more **armament**.

- Soldiers guard the water and electricity works, **armament** factories, railway stations and post offices.
- Instruments of disarmament rather than of **armament**.
- His first war appointment was to oversee the construction of **armament** factories and military installations.

6. Flitting

Kannada : ಹಗುರವಾಗಿ, ವೇಗವಾಗಿ ಹಾರಾಡುವುದು, ಹಾರಾಡುವ ಅಥವಾ ಲಘುವಾಗಿ ಅಲೆದಾಡುವುದು

Hindi : झटपट चल पड़ना

Meaning: to make an irregular series of quick, sudden movements

Synonyms: darting, fluttering, wandering

Antonyms : Settling, Staying, Remaining, Lingering, Resting

Sentence:

- Bargain hunters at the flea market **flitted** from table to table like hummingbirds in a garden.
- The hummingbird **flitted** from flower to flower.
- She was always **flitting** around the kitchen.

7. Goof

Kannada : ಪೆದ್ದ, ದಡ್ಡ, ಹೊಲಸೆಬ್ಬಿಸು

Hindi : मूर्ख

Meaning: a stupid person

Synonyms: idiot, moron, stupid

Antonyms: genius, brain, whiz

Sentence:

- I just stood there like a **goof** waiting for him to introduce her.
- I can't believe I let that **goof** get away with it.
- He made a huge **goof** on the final exam.
- Forgetting my keys was a big **goof** on my part.
- We spent the whole afternoon just **goofing** around at the park instead of doing chores.

8. Insularity

Kannada : ದ್ವೀಪಸ್ಥಿತಿ, ದ್ವೀಪತ್ವ, ಬೇರ್ಪಡುವಿಕೆ, ಸಂಕೀರ್ಣತೆ, ಸಂಕುಚಿತ ಮನೋಭಾವ, ಅಥವಾ ಪ್ರತ್ಯೇಕತೆ

Hindi : संकीर्णता

Meaning: ignorance of or lack of interest in cultures, ideas, or peoples outside one's own experience.

Synonyms: narrow-mindedness, parochialism, provincialism

Antonyms: tolerance, liberalism

Sentence:

- But will Dublin's **insularity** prove to be its downfall?
- He proved the **insularity** of Van Diemen's Land by circumnavigating it in 1798.

- The stifling **insularity** of the children's existence.
- An example of British **insularity**.

9. Dulcet

Kannada : ಮಧುರವಾದ, ಸಿಹಿ, ಅಥವಾ ಕಿವಿಗೆ ಆಹ್ಲಾದಕರ

Hindi : आनंदकर

Meaning: giving pleasure or contentment to the mind or senses

Synonyms: delightful, enjoyable, felicitous

Antonyms: unpalatable, unpleasant, disturbing

Sentence:

- She recorded the **dulcet** tones of her family and friends.
- You'll just have to imagine what my **dulcet** tones sound like.
- Eecord the **dulcet** tones of your family and friends.
- Instead of the **dulcet** sounds of 'Silent Night', there are imprecations emanating from the kitchen.
- Occupational hazards of hairdressers include having to listen to the **dulcet** tones of their clients.

10. Singe

Kannada : ಸುಡು, ಕಮರಿಸು, ಕರಿಕಾಗಿಸು ಅಥವಾ ಮೇಲೆ ಲೋಟಕ್ಕೆ ಸುಡು

Hindi : जलाना

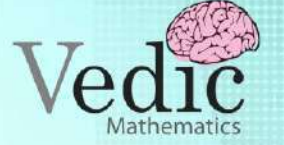
