1. Sequester

Kannada : ಬಂಧಿಸು, ಪ್ರತ್ಯೇಕವಾಗಿರಿಸು, ಬೇರೆಬೇರೆಯಾಗಿರಿಸು

Hindi : अलग करना

Meaning: to set or keep apart from others

Synonyms: isolate, separate, remove

Antonyms: integrate, join, connect

Sentence:

- Everything he owned was **sequestered**.
- He was **sequestered** in his room.
- The jury was **sequestered** until a verdict was reached.
- She **sequestered** herself from other children, preferring the solitude of prayer.
- A large area of the park has been **sequestered** from people who should have the enjoyment of it.
- He said all coal plants should be closed until they find a way to **sequester** the carbon dioxide they emit.
- The wetlands ringing a beaver pond **sequester** carbon and clean the water, filtering out pollutants like nitrogen and phosphorus.
- The dormitory at Casa Santa Marta, where the cardinals are **sequestered**, is purposefully more modern than the Sistine Chapel and the other Vatican rooms.

2. Replete

Kannada : ತುಂಬು, ಪೂರ್ತಿತುಂಬಿದ, ಹೇರಳವಾದ

Hindi : परिपूर्ण

Meaning: possessing or covered with great numbers or amounts of something specified

Synonyms: filled, packed, abundant

Antonyms: devoid, empty, blank

Sentence:

- The Harbor was **replete** with boats.
- The 12 inch came **replete** with a four track CD that screamed 'SHARE ME'.
- I went out into the sun-drenched streets again, **replete** and relaxed.
- The book is **replete** with historical references.
- Sensational popular fiction, **replete** with adultery and sudden death.

3. Memento

Kannada : ಸ್ಮರಣಿಕೆ, ಸ್ಮಾರಕ, ಜ್ಞಾಪಕ ವಸ್ತು

Hindi : स्मृति चिन्ह

Meaning: something that serves to keep alive the memory of a person or event

Synonyms: reminder, memorial, souvenir

Antonyms : Forgetfulness, Oblivion, Neglect, Loss, Amnesia

Sentence:

- They gave him a watch as a **memento** of his time with the company.

4. Debacle

Kannada : ಸೋಲು, ನೂಕುನುಗ್ಗಲು, ರಭಸ ಪ್ರವಾಹ, ಕೊಚ್ಚು ಪ್ರವಾಹ, ಗೊಂದಲ

Hindi : असफलता

Meaning: a sudden and ignominious failure; a fiasco.

Synonyms: fiasco, failure, downfall

Antonyms: success, victory

Sentence:

- The economic **debacle** that became known as the Great Depression.
- The only man to reach double figures in the second-innings **debacle**.
- The carefully planned operation turned into a complete **debacle**.

5. Knickknack

Kannada : ಮಿರುಗುವ ಥಳುಕಿನ ಒಡವೆ, ಚಿಕ್ಕ ಉಡುಗೊರೆ, ಅಲಂಕಾರಿಕ ವಸ್ತು, ಸಣ್ಣ ಸೌಂದರ್ಯ ವಸ್ತು

Hindi : सजावटी

Meaning: a small object displayed for its attractiveness or interest

Synonyms: ornamental, collectable

Antonyms: doodah, thingamajig, bags of, big part of, broad assortment, considerable quantity, diamond, good deal of

Sentence:

- The shelves were covered with ornaments and useless **knick-knacks**.
- She decorated the shelf with colorful **knickknacks** she collected from her travels.

6. Wane

Kannada : ತಗ್ಗು, ಕುಗ್ಗು, ಕ್ಷಯಿಸು

Hindi : पतन

Meaning: to grow less in scope or intensity especially gradually

Synonyms: diminish, decrease, decline

Antonyms: rise, grow, increase

Sentence:

- Their political power is on the **wane**.
- I cut the log into slabs without removing the outside **wane**.
- Her interest in science fiction began to **wane**.

7. Conciliatory

Kannada : ಸಮಾಧಾನಕರ, ಉಪಶಮನ ಮಾಡುವ, ರಾಜಿಮಾಡಿಸುವ, ಸಮಾಧಾನಗೊಳಿಸುವ

Hindi : शांति

Meaning: intended or likely to placate or pacify.

Synonyms: propitiatory, placatory, appeasing

Antonyms: antagonizing, abrasive, aggravating

Sentence:

- I've had a **conciliatory** letter from the council offering to pay for the damage.
- O'Brien, on the other hand, is mild-mannered and **conciliatory** in his approach.

8. Torrid

Kannada : ಸುಡುಬಿಸಿಲಿನ, ಭಾವೋದ್ರೇಕದ

Hindi : गरम

Meaning: having a notably high temperature

Synonyms: searing, boiling, hot

Antonyms: cold, icy, glacial

Sentence:

- It was a **torrid** summer day.

- I was indulging in the **torrid** heat of a thermal bath.
- It was another **torrid** day on the world's stock exchanges.
- Most come with **torrid** messages of love expressed in poetry.
- They had a **torrid** time trying to equalize the score.

9. Stoicism

Kannada : ಸ್ಥಿತಪ್ರಜ್ಞತೆ , ಸಹನಶೀಲತೆ, ಉದಾಸೀನತೆ

Hindi : धैर्य

Meaning: the quality or behavior of a person who accepts what happens without complaining or showing emotion

Synonyms: patience, forbearance, calmness

Antonyms : impatience, anger, irritableness, snappiness, brusqueness, disquietude, fretfulness, edginess, testiness, uneasiness

Sentence:

- She endured his criticism with her usual **stoicism**.
- That most shoulder this burden with little complaint says much for their courage and **stoicism**.
- Clearly, endurance here means much more than tight-lipped **stoicism**.

Hindi : चालाकी

Meaning: clever or cunning devices or expedients, especially as used to trick or deceive others.

Synonyms: trickery, deviousness, deceit

Antonyms: sincerity, honesty

Sentence:

- His remorse is just an **artifice** to gain sympathy.
- He alone supplied the deft and necessary touch of self-conscious theatrical **artifice**.
- Parker exposes the vanity, **artifice** and delusion that stand behind these apparently candid books.
- An industry dominated by **artifice**.
