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1. Rapport

Kannada : ಬಾಂಧವ್ಯ, ಸೌಹಾರ್ದ ಸಂಬಂಧದ, ಸಹೃದಯ ಸಂಬಂಧದ, ಹೊಂದಾಣಿಕೆ, ಸಾಮರಸ್ಯ, ಒಮ್ಮತ ಸಂಬಂಧ, ನಿಕಟ ಬಾಂಧವ್ಯ, ವಿಶ್ವಾಸದ ಸಂಬಂಧ, ಮನಸ್ಸುಗಳ ಹೊಂದಾಣಿಕೆ

Hindi : तालमेल

Meaning: a friendly relationship marked by ready communication and mutual understanding

Synonyms: friendship, solidarity, communion

Antonyms: alienation, disaffection, estrangement

Sentence:

- He had an excellent **rapport** with his patients.
- There was little **rapport** between them.
- She was able to establish a good **rapport** with the children.
- We quickly established a **rapport**, and it fell to me to tell him his diagnosis.
- It's important to establish a good **rapport** with your clients.

2. Cachet

Kannada : ಛಾಪು, ಮುದ್ರೆ, ಸೀಲು, ಗುರುತು, ಕುರುಹು

Hindi : प्रतिष्ठा

Meaning: a characteristic or quality that confers the favorable regard or respect of people

Synonyms: prestige, stature, position

Antonyms: shame, odium, pettiness

Sentence:

- No other brand name has quite the same **cachet**.
- A movie director with great artistic **cachet**.
- His research in Antarctica gave him a certain **cachet** among other scientists.

3. Gratuitous

Kannada : ಅನವೇಕ್ಷಿತ, ಸಂಪಾದಿಸದೆ, ಬೆಲೆ ಕೊಡದೆ, ಪುಕ್ಕಟೆ, ಉಚಿತವಾದ, ಬೇಡದ, ಬೆಲೆಕೇಳದ, ಕೇಳದೆ ಕೊಟ್ಟ, ಅಕಾರಣವಾದ, ಬಿಟ್ಟಿಪಡೆದ, ನಿಷ್ಕಾರಣವಾದ

Hindi : अनावश्यक

Meaning: not needed by the circumstances or to accomplish an end

Synonyms: unnecessary, extra, needless

Antonyms: necessary, essential, required

Sentence:

- There's too much crime and **gratuitous** violence on TV.
- There is plenty of violence in the film, but it is not **gratuitous**.





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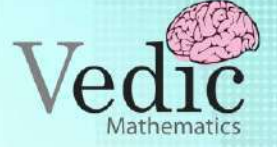
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- His action was a blatant and **gratuitous** insult to the people of this town.
- This is **gratuitous** violence, sick, bone - crunching, vicious and obscene.
- It was a voluntary and **gratuitous** offer by the chambers to provide education and training.

4. Signet

Kannada : ಮುದ್ರಿಕೆ, ಮುದ್ರೆ, ಮೊಹರು

Hindi : मुहर

Meaning: a small seal, especially one set in a ring, used instead of or with a signature to give authentication to an official document.

Synonyms : badge, certification, device, emblem, endorsement, indication, mark, ratification.

Antonyms : open, unseal, unfasten, ride

Sentence:

- Such letters are sealed with the cardinal's own **signet** ring
- She wanted to reach out and put her hand over his, covering his fingers and the gold **signet** ring.
- Her head snapped back and his **signet** cut her cheek, leaving a thin smear of blood on the back of his hand.

- And what message did that heavy gold **signet** ring on his left small finger convey?

5. Absolve

Kannada : ವಿಮೋಚನೆಗೊಳಿಸು, ದೋಷದಿಂದಮುಕ್ತಗೊಳಿಸು, ದೂರು ಹಿಂತೆಗೆ

Hindi : विमुक्त करना

Meaning: set or declare (someone) free from blame, guilt, or responsibility.

Synonyms: acquit, exonerate, vindicate

Antonyms: incriminate, accuse, charge

Sentence:

- They agree to **absolve** us from our obligation.
- The jury **absolved** the defendants of their crimes.
- Her youth does not **absolve** her of responsibility for her actions.

6. Acquisitive

Kannada : ಸ್ವಾಧೀನಪಡಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳುವ

Hindi : प्राप्त करने की लालसावाला

Meaning: having or marked by an eager and often selfish desire especially for material possessions

Synonyms: greedy, mercenary, eager

Antonyms: generous, liberal, charitable





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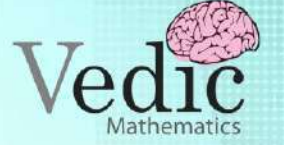
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Sentence:

- We live in an **acquisitive** society.
- Professionals seemed as greedy and **acquisitive** as any other group of workers.
- We live in a competitive and **acquisitive** society.

7. Inveigh

Kannada : ತನಿಖೆ ಮಾಡಿ, ಆಕ್ರೋಶದಿಂದ ಮಾತನಾಡು ಯಾ ಬರೆ

Hindi : असंतोष प्रकट करना

Meaning: to express dissatisfaction, pain, or resentment usually tiresomely

Synonyms: complain, whine

Antonyms: rejoice, delight, accept

Sentence:

- A lot of his writings **inveigh** against luxury and riches.
- It **inveighs** against welfare states as well as market monopolies.
- Newspapers **inveighed** against the decision and residents held indignation meetings to agitate against it.
- He **inveighed** strongly against all academical rules and principles.

8. Maladroit

Kannada : ಅಕುಶಲ, ನಯನಾಜೂಕಿಲ್ಲದ, ಒಡ್ಡೊಡ್ಡಾದ, ತಪ್ಪು ತಪ್ಪಾದ, ವಿವೇಚನೆಯಿಲ್ಲದ, ಚಾತುರ್ಯವಿಲ್ಲದ, ವಿಚಕ್ಷಣೆಯಿಲ್ಲದ

Hindi : अयोग्य

Meaning: lacking or showing a lack of nimbleness in using one's hands

Synonyms: bungling, awkward, inept

Antonyms: dextrous, skilled

Sentence:

- The young man's **maladroit** remarks about the hostess embarrassed everyone at the party.
- Billings was a clumsy, **maladroit** man, his fingers astonishingly competent with a wireless set, his other limbs ungainly and shambling.
- I'm supposed to be the socially **maladroit** academic being swallowed alive by the hot nightclub singer.

9. Voracious

Kannada : ಹೊಟ್ಟೆಬಾಕತನ, ಬಕಾಸುರನಂಥ, ಅತ್ಯಾಸೆಯ, ತಿಂಡಿಪೋತನಾದ, ತುಂಬಾ ಹಸಿದ, ಸರ್ವಗ್ರಾಹಿಯಾದ

Hindi : पेटू





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Meaning: wanting or devouring great quantities of food.

Synonyms: insatiable, unquenchable, unappeasable

Antonyms: satisfied, full, glutton

Sentence:

- It seemed like the **voracious** kitten was eating her weight in food every day.
- She's a **voracious** reader.
- That child has a **voracious** appetite!
- Hedgehogs have a **voracious** appetite for the birds' eggs.
- These animals are **voracious** eaters.

10. Haggard

Kannada : ಕಂಗಾಲಾದ, ವಳಗಿಲ್ಲದ, ನರವೇತಲ, ಕಂಗೆಟ್ಟ, ಬಡಕಲು, ಸಣಕಲು, ಬಡಕಲಾಗಿರುವ, ರಾವು ಬಡಿದಂತೆ ಕಾಣುವ, ಅತ್ಯಂತ ಬಳಲಿದ

Hindi : थका हुआ

Meaning: looking exhausted and unwell, especially from fatigue, worry, or suffering.

Synonyms: tired, drained, unwell

Antonyms: healthy, fit

Sentence:

- He looked pale and **haggard**.
- Like all the street children, he is thin and **haggard**.
- I saw him again yesterday and he still looks **haggard** and tired.
