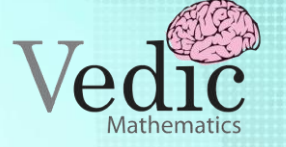

1. Astuteness

Kannada : ಚುರುಕುತನ

Hindi : चालबाज़ी

Meaning: exceptional discernment and judgment especially in practical matters

Synonyms: shrewdness, acumen, sagaciousness

Antonyms: stupidity, vacuity, witlessness

Sentence:

- He was a political observer renowned for her **astuteness**.
- She is admired for her political **astuteness**. Commercial **astuteness** and an ability to attract talented designers and engineers have made the company a success.
- **Astuteness** is what made him successful at negotiating foreign cultures.
- His **astuteness** is his greatest asset on the tennis court.

2. Acclimatize

Kannada : ಬಗ್ಗಿಕೊಳ್ಳಿ, ಬಗ್ಗಿಸು

Hindi : अभ्यस्त बनाना

Meaning: to change (something) to make it suitable for a new use or situation

Synonyms: acclimate, accommodate, adapt

Antonyms: misadjust

Sentence:

- Runners had to **acclimatize** to the humid tropical conditions.
- He flew to Nice to **acclimatize** himself, two days before Neville was due.
- It took a moment to **acclimatize** to the sudden light and to the brightness of violent colour; there was blood everywhere.

3. Imperceptibly

Kannada : ಅಗ್ರಾಹ್ಯವಾಗಿ

Hindi : अगोचर रूप से

Meaning: in a way that is so slight, gradual, or subtle as not to be perceived.

Synonyms: crecively, gradually

Antonyms: abruptly, suddenly

Sentence:

- The disease develops gradually and **imperceptibly**.
- The corners of her mouth rose almost **imperceptibly**.
- On the first song, chimes segue **imperceptibly** into electronic bleeps.
- Spring has slipped **imperceptibly** into summer.

4. Lambent

Kannada : ಸುಡದೆ ಸುಳಿದಾಡುವ, ಮಿದು ಬೆಳಕಿನ, ಮೃದುವಾದ

Hindi : उज्ज्वल

Meaning: (of light or fire) glowing, gleaming, or flickering with a soft radiance.

Synonyms: beaming, luminous, glowing

Antonyms: dim, dull, dark

Sentence:

- The **lambent** flames from our campfire cast a comforting glow.
- She was so quick, and so **lambent**, like discernible fire, and so vindictive, and so rich in her dangerous flamy sensitiveness.

5. Esurient

Kannada : ಹಸಿದ, ದುರಾಸೆಯ, ಗತಿಗೆಟ್ಟು

Hindi : लालची

Meaning: having a huge appetite

Synonyms: edacious, gluttonous, greedy

Antonyms: gluttoned, sated, satiated

Sentence:

- It would be silly to leave your **esurient** brother in charge of the three dozen cupcakes you baked for a birthday party

- He skipped breakfast, so by lunch he was positively **esurient**.
- Don't be so **esurient** when it comes to money — there's dignity in having what you need and no more.
- Some consider Leopold II of Belgium to be one of the most **esurient** figures in history.

6. Quibbling

Kannada : ಧ್ವಂದ್ವಾರ್ಥದ ಮಾತು, ಮಾತು ಹೊರಳಿಸು, ಧ್ವಂದ್ವಾರ್ಥ ಬರುವಂತೆ ಮಾತನಾಡು, ಕುತರ್ಕದ ಮಾತು

Hindi : आपत्तियां उठाना

Meaning: the action of raising objections about a trivial matter.

Synonyms: criticizing, niggling

Antonyms: approving, supporting

Sentence:

- He spent the entire evening **quibbling** about the historical inaccuracies in the television series on World War II.
- She was tired of all the **quibbling**.
- It isn't worth **quibbling** over such a small amount.
- And not that Williams was **quibbling** with the nature of the win.
- He came back with a **quibbling** rebuttal.

7. Upheaval

Kannada : ಏರುಪೇರು, ಕ್ರಾಂತಿ, ವಿಪ್ಲವ, ಉತ್ಥಾನ

Hindi : उथल-पुथल

Meaning: a violent or sudden change or disruption to something.

Synonyms: disruption, disturbance, disorder

Antonyms : stability, tranquility, disruption, upset, disturbance, trouble

Sentence:

- The company underwent a massive **upheaval** after the takeover.
- The first **upheaval** produced a hill which was called Roof Mountain.
- It was a time of social **upheaval**.
- I can't face the **upheaval** of moving house again.
- We went through a period of political and social **upheaval**.

8. Ternary

Kannada : ತ್ರಯಾತ್ಮಕ, ತ್ರಯಾಧಾರಿತ, ಮೂರು

Hindi : त्रिगुट

Meaning: composed of three parts.

Synonyms: triad, triplet, trio

Antonyms: ordinal, divide, multiply, integrate, Etymology

Sentence:

- The code used to represent information with a **ternary** number.
- The traditional order of the three estates had combined two binary distinctions to produce a **ternary** structure of knights, clergy, and commons.
- We conclude that all three patterns are robust and that they exist in stable **ternary** variation.

9. Quietus

Kannada : ನಿಶ್ಯಬ್ಧ, ಮುಕ್ತಾಯ, ಅಂತ್ಯ, ತೀರಿಕೆಯ ರಸೀದಿ, ವಿಮೋಚನೆ

Hindi : मरण

Meaning: death or something that causes death, regarded as a release from life.

Synonyms: death, decease, demise

Antonyms: birth, nativity, existence

Sentence:

- After weeks of suffering, the cancer-stricken cat received a **quietus** of the pain by taking her final nap.
- I doubt it, else he might have already sought without my help the **quietus** I am about to give him.
- My father's frenzies had been infrequent but terrible and, always followed by a **quietus** that lasted days, sometimes weeks.





10. Pantomimed

Kannada : ಮಕ್ಕಳ ನಾಟಕ, ಮೂಕ ವೇಷಧಾರಿ,

ಸನ್ನೆನುಡಿ

Hindi : अभिव्यक्त करना

Meaning: express or represent (something) by extravagant and exaggerated mime.

Synonyms: gestured, signed, signalized

Antonyms : aid, calm, calmness, help, order, peace, harmony, quiet, repose, rest

Sentence:

- The clown candidates **pantomimed** different emotions.
- We saw **pantomimes** at the fair.
- A ballet that is part dance and part **pantomime**.
- He **pantomimed** someone talking on the phone.
