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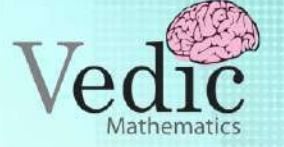
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1. Exoneration

Kannada : ದೋಷಮುಕ್ತಗೊಳಿಸುವಿಕೆ

Hindi : छुटकारा

Meaning: the action of officially absolving someone from blame; vindication.

Synonyms: vindication, freeing from blame, absolution

Antonyms: conviction, accusation, arraignment

Sentence:

- They expected complete **exoneration** for their clients.
- Herring is continuing to press for complete **exoneration**.
- The defendants' eventual **exoneration**.

2. Probity

Kannada : ಪ್ರಾಮಾಣಿಕತೆ, ಸಾಚಾಗುಣ, ನಿಷ್ಕವಟ

Hindi : ईमानदारी

Meaning: the quality of having strong moral principles; honesty and decency.

Synonyms: integrity, honesty, uprightness

Antonyms: badness, evil, evildoing

Sentence:

- Her **probity** and integrity are beyond question.
- They should always behave with **probity** and integrity '.

- We need to apply the same standards of **probity** and integrity to all employees.
- Brace yourself, for this is a rare tale of integrity and **probity** in business.
- He writes so well; with historical understanding and moral **probity**.

3. Effrontery

Kannada : ಆಕ್ರಮಣಶೀಲತೆ, ನಿರ್ಲಜ್ಜ, ಮಾನಗಟ್ಟತನ

Hindi : गुस्ताखी

Meaning: insolent or impertinent behavior.

Synonyms: impudence, impertinence, audacity

Antonyms: civility, courtesy, gentility

Sentence:

- One juror had the **effrontery** to challenge the coroner's decision.
- On the whole, however, he carries the reader with him by sheer **effrontery**.
- One juror had the **effrontery** to challenge the coroner's decision.
- He then committed several acts of brazen **effrontery**.

4. Impediment

Kannada : ಅಡಚಣೆ, ವಿರೋಧ, ತಡೆ, ಅಡ್ಡಿ, ತೊಡಕು, ಅಡೆತಡೆ





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Hindi : बाधा

Meaning: a hindrance or obstruction in doing something.

Synonyms: hindrance, obstruction, obstacle

Antonyms: catalyst, goad, impetus

Sentence:

- He was satisfied there was no legal **impediment** to the marriage.
- He had a speech **impediment** as a child.
- Sir Peter has a slight speech **impediment**.
- People tell me they don't notice my hearing **impediment**.
- Therein may lie a serious **impediment** to success.

5. Dispirit

Kannada : ಹುರುಪುಗಡಿಸು, , ಗೆಲುವು ಗಡಿಸು, ನಿರುತ್ಸಾಹಗೊಳಿಸು

Hindi : उदास करना

Meaning: cause (someone) to lose enthusiasm or hope.

Synonyms: dishearten, discourage, demoralize

Antonyms: emboldened, encouraged, heartened

Sentence:

- She refused to be **dispirited** by her long illness.

- **Dispirited** by the overwhelming amount of information needed to write the report
- While many artists said they were **dispirited** by the slow pace of progress.
- It was a little **dispiriting** to see so few people at the meeting".
- There has been a **dispiriting** fall in sales.
- He cannot hope to defeat Tesse, but he may wear out and **dispirit** his men by constant attacks.
- William, like a wise general as he was, took care that the news of his accident should not **dispirit** his men.

6. Clobber

Kannada : ಉಡುಗೆ ತೊಡುಗೆ

Hindi : पीटना

Meaning: hit (someone) hard.

Synonyms: hit, strike, slap

Antonyms : decompression, hate, arrive, insulator, conductor, unclog, unstuff

Sentence:

- If he does that I'll **clobber** him!
- Just dump your **clobber** anywhere.
- still wearing the same **clobber** he wore as an undergrad at Cambridge Verb If you say anything I'll **clobber** you.
- We **clobbered** them in our last game.





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7. Fidelity

Kannada : ನಿಷ್ಠೆ, ಶ್ರದ್ಧೆ, ತತ್ತ್ವ ನಿಷ್ಠೆ, ನಂಬಿಕೆ

Hindi : सत्य के प्रति निष्ठा

Meaning: faithfulness to a person, cause, or belief, demonstrated by continuing loyalty and support.

Synonyms: loyalty, allegiance, obedience

Antonyms: disloyalty, faithlessness, falseness

Sentence:

- I had to promise **fidelity** to the Queen.
- I admire her **fidelity** to her beliefs.
- He sought only the strictest **fidelity** to justice.
- We rely on the **fidelity** of our customers.
- They have maintained **fidelity** to their principles.

8. Prefatory

Kannada : ಪೂರ್ವಭಾವಿ, ಪ್ರಸ್ತಾವನೆಯ, ಪೀಠಿಕಾ ರೂಪದ

Hindi : प्रारंभिक

Meaning: serving as an introduction; introductory.

Synonyms: introductory, preliminary, opening

Antonyms: after, behind, end

Sentence:

- The poet makes this clear in a **prefatory** note on the text.
- The speaker made some **prefatory** remarks.
- Each chapter in the book has a **prefatory** quotation.

9. Flawed

Kannada : ದೋಷಪೂರಿತ, ದೋಷ, ಬಿರುಕು, ಕಳಂಕ, ನ್ಯೂನತೆ

Hindi : त्रुटिपूर्ण

Meaning: blemished, damaged, or imperfect in some way.

Synonyms: unsound, defective, faulty

Antonyms: faultless, flawless, impeccable

Sentence:

- The material is **flawed** throughout.
- Fitz took the archetype of the **flawed** hero to new extremes.
- The main character is a **flawed** hero.
- The computer game was **flawed** by poor programming.
- It's unusual to have such a **flawed** hero in a major picture.

10. Placate

Kannada : ಸಮಾಧಾನಪಡಿಸು, ಶಾಂತಗೊಳಿಸು, ಸಂತೈಸು





Hindi : तसल्ली देना

Meaning: make (someone) less angry or hostile.

Synonyms: pacify, calm, appease

Antonyms: anger, enrage, incense

Sentence:

- They attempted to placate the students with promises.
- This doesn't placate anyone or calm things down or keep order.
- He has tried to placate his critics within the party.
- Take a saucer of milk to placate him and you might just escape unscathed.
- It adopts no postures of phony charms to placate its visitors.

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
