1. Deceive

Kannada : ಮೋಸ ಮಾಡಿ, ನಿರಾಶೆ ಗೊಳಿಸು, ವಂಚಿಸು

Hindi : धोखा देना

Meaning: (of a person) cause (someone) to believe something that is not true, typically in order to gain some personal advantage.

Synonyms: swindle, defraud, cheat Antonyms: undeceive, expose, reveal Sentence:

- Good words and ill deeds deceive wise and fools.
- 'We shouldn't **deceive** ourselves about this man,' the president said.
- Only someone determined to deceive himself or others would pretend otherwise.

2. Ingrained

Kannada: ಬೇರೂರಿದೆ, ರೂಢಮೂಲ

Hindi : दीर्घस्थायी

Meaning: (of a habit, belief, or attitude) firmly fixed or established; difficult to change.

Synonyms: built-in, entrenched, established

Antonyms: adventitious, extraneous, extrinsic

Sentence:

Morals tend to be deeply ingrained.

- He sat there surrounded by filth thick ingrained dirt.
- I had an ingrained distrust of doctors.
- The ingrained dirt on the flaking paintwork.
- This product removes ingrained grime.

3. Surfeit

Kannada : ಅತ್ರಿ, ಪುಷ್ಕಳತ್ರೆ, ವಿಪರೀತ್ರ ಹೇರಳ

Hindi : अतिरेक

Meaning: an excessive amount of something.

Synonyms: excess, surplus, abundance
Antonyms: deficiency, deficit, insufficiency
Sentence:

- The country has a surfeit of cheap labour.
- A surfeit of food and drink.
- He died of a surfeit.
- We've been left with a surfeit of oranges.
- That's no mean boast, since there's a surfeit of super-featherweight talent around.

4. Baiting

Kannada: ಯಾವುದಾದರೂ ವಸ್ತುವನ್ನು ಆಸಕ್ತಿ ಹುಟ್ಟಿಸಲು ಅಥವಾ ಕೆರಳಿಸಲು ಬಳಸುವ ಆಮಿಷ, ಅಥವಾ ಒಬ್ಬರನ್ನು ಕೆರಳಿಸಲು ಅಥವಾ ಕೋಪಗೊಳಿಸಲು

Hindi : उत्पीड़न

Meaning: deliberately annoy or taunt (someone).

Synonyms: taunt, goad, provoke

Antonyms: appease, conciliate, mollify

Sentence:

- I wished the candidates would stop baiting each other and instead address the real issues.
- The teacher said they were baiting each other, with the defendant admitting he taunted Harvey in an effort to get him to lose his cool.
- And Fogelman enjoys baiting him, telling Brown that if they played a game of one-on-one basketball, Fogelman would get at least one point.

5. Volition

Kannada : ಸಂಕಲ್ಪ, ಇಚ್ಟೆ

Hindi : इच्छाशक्ति

Meaning: the faculty or power of using one's will.

Synonyms: accord, autonomy, self-determination

Antonyms: coercion, compulsion

Sentence:

- Oftentimes the dialect we speak is completely beyond our volition.
- He did it of his own volition.

- We were pleased to see her take action of her own volition.
- Without conscious volition she backed into her office.

6. Sageness

Kannada : ಋಷಿತ್ವ, ಪ್ರಾಜ್ಞತೆ, ಗಾಢ ಜ್ಞಾನ

Hindi : ब्द्धिमता

Meaning: the ability to understand inner

qualities

Synonyms: discernment, insight,

perception

Antonyms: dullness, folly, foolishness

Sentence:

- Her father has always shown an unpretentious sageness about the practicalities of life.
- The group listened to the elder's words
 with quiet sageness, recognizing the
 deep wisdom behind his thoughtful
 advice.
- Her sageness was evident in the way she calmly handled the difficult situation.
- The elder's words were filled with sageness, a profound and experienced wisdom.
- He offered sage advice, not just information, showing great understanding and insight.
- Her sageness allowed her to remain calm and composed in the face of adversity.

7. Jeering

Kannada: ಗೇಲಿ ಮಾಡುವುದು, ಅಪಹಾಸ್ಯ ಮಾಡುವುದು ಅಥವಾ ಅಸಭ್ಯವಾಗಿ ಮಾತನಾಡುವುದು

Hindi : मजाक उडाना

Meaning: making rude and mocking remarks, typically in a loud voice.

Synonyms: deriding, gibing, laughing (at) Antonyms: applauding, commending, endorsing

Sentence:

- Others began jeering and eventually threw bottles and stones.
- He couldn't stand her jeering.
- Fans started jeering their own team.
- He had to suffer the jeering and mockery of his classmates.

8. Contemplate

Kannada : ಆಲೋಚಿಸಿ, ಧ್ಯಾನಿಸು, ವೀಕ್ಷಿಸು, ಅವಲೋಕಿಸು, ಚಿಂತಿಸು

Hindi: मनन करना

Meaning: look thoughtfully for a long time at.

Synonyms: look at, view, regard

Antonyms: disregard, ignore, overlook

Sentence:

- The possibility of war is too horrifying to contemplate.
- It's at times like these when I sit and contemplate and plot.

- It does not contemplate damage of the present type.
- When we **contemplate** the universe, we can feel very small.
- She couldn't even begin to contemplate the future.

9. Conscience

Kannada: ಆತ್ಮಸಾಕ್ಷ್ಮಿ

Hindi: अंतरात्मा की आवाज

Meaning: an inner feeling or voice viewed as acting as a guide to the rightness or wrongness of one's behavior.

Synonyms: sense of right and wrong, moral sense, inner voice

Antonyms: Immorality, Corruption, Sinfulness. Wickedness. Depravity, Amorality, Unconsciousness (in moral sense), Indifference, Shamelessness, Insensitivity

Sentence:

- Her conscience told her to find the lost wallet's owner.
- Do you have a clear conscience?
- Have you no conscience?
- That's between you and your conscience.
- It may not change anything, but you will have a clear conscience.



Synonyms: sheer, fine, ultra-fine Antonyms: opaque, cloudy, foggy
