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1. Unconscionable

Synonyms: unethical, amoral, immoral

Antonyms: ethical, moral, principled

Sentence:

- You take an **unconscionable** time getting dressed!
- Shareholders have had to wait an unconscionable time for the facts to be established.
- The **unconscionable** conduct of his son.
- It alleged that the transaction was unconscionable, inequitable and unreasonable.

2. Mutiny

Sentence:

- Thousands of the soldiers mutinied over the non-payment of wages.
- The crew were on the verge of **mutiny**.
- A **mutiny** by those manning the weapons could trigger a global war.
- This brought about a mutiny led by a group of officers based in Algeria.
- Within a week the **mutiny** had spread to revolution in every big city in Germany.

3. Vehemence

- She was astonished at his **vehemence**.
- She argued with such vehemence against the proposal that they decided to abandon it.
- "No!" she said with sudden vehemence.
- They were taken aback by the **vehemence** of the response.

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I was surprised by the vehemence in my own voice.

4. Rugged

- He was known for his rugged good looks.
- His face was rugged and handsome.
- The actor is famous for his rugged good looks.
- The vehicle is built for **rugged** terrain.

5. Debasement

Kannada: ಅಪನಗದೀಕರಣ, ಕೆಡಿಸುವಿಕೆ,

ಗುಣತಗ್ಗಿಸಿಕೆ, ಬೆಲೆಯಿಳಿತ, ಗುಣಪತನ

Hindi : मानमदेन

Meaning: the action or process of reducing the quality or value of something.

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Synonyms: abjection, corruptness, debauchery

Antonyms: morality, righteousness, virtue Sentence:

- The outcome is rot and **debasement** of the system.
- This involved a **debasement** of the currency of 4.97%.
- In 1695 the government decided to increase the amount of metal money in circulation by debasement.
- At the height of the **debasement**, there was a 430% inflation rate for copper and commerce ceased, forcing several businesses and manufacturers to close down.

6. Ruses



8. Crucify

Meaning: criticize (someone) severely and unrelentingly.

Synonyms: condemn, criticize severely,

denounce

Antonyms: commend, endorse

He's going to **crucify** me when he finds out what I've done!

9. Abrogate

- Both governments voted to abrogate the treaty.
- A proposal to **abrogate** temporarily the right to strike.
- In 1975, Moscow decided to abrogate this agreement.

10. Seclusion

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


