historical significance in India

Birth Anniversary of notable personalities: It is the birth anniversary of figures like Bankim Chandra Chatterjee (renowned novelist, poet, and journalist, known for "Vande Mataram")

Bankim Chandra Chatterjee: 26 or 27 June 1838 – 8 April 1894) was an Indian Bengali novelist, poet,



essayist and journalist. He was the author of the 1882 Bengali language novel Ananda which is one of the landmarks of modern Bengali and Indian literature. He was the composer of Vande Mataram, written

highly Sanskritised Bengali, personifying India as a mother goddess and inspiring activists during the Indian Independence Movement. Chattopadhayay wrote fourteen novels and many serious, serio-comic, satirical, scientific and critical treatises in Bengali. He is known as Sahitya Samrat (Emperor of Literature) in Bengali.

Historical Events

On this day in 1914, the Indian Relief Act was passed, which abolished a £3 tax imposed on Indians who had not renewed their indentures and recognized the validity of Indian customary marriages.

International Days

International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking: This is a United Nations international day observed annually since 1989 to raise awareness about the major problems that illicit drugs pose to society and

to promote action and cooperation for a drug-free world.



Drug use impacts security, safety, and development, costing some countries up to 2% of their GDP due to health-related expenses, crime, and lost productivity. Beyond its economic burden, drug use constitutes a significant public health issue, linked to a range of health issues, including mental health conditions, hepatitis, tuberculosis, and cardiovascular diseases. Despite these public health implications, drug use has been overwhelmingly addressed through a law enforcement and supply restriction lens, using strategies that reinforce stigma and overlook the health dimensions of the issue.

International Day in Support of Victims of Torture:

Also a UN observance, this day highlights that torture is a crime under international law and calls for solidarity with victims of torture.


