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### 1. Bizarre

**Kannada :** ವಿಲಕ್ಷಣ, ವಿಚಿತ್ರ

**Hindi :** विचित्र

**Meaning:** very strange or unusual, especially so as to cause interest or amusement.

**Synonyms:** strange, peculiar, odd

**Antonyms:** common, average, ordinary

**Sentence:**

- He gave a **bizarre** excuse for getting home so late.
- The film had a rather **bizarre** twist at the end.
- What a truly **bizarre** thing to say!
- Yet it is the **bizarre**, unexpected moments in life that are the ones we remember.
- Oh yeah, one of those **bizarre** little coincidence things happened to me yesterday.

### 2. Batter

**Kannada :** ಕಟುವಾಗಿ ಟೀಕಿಸು, ಒಂದೇ ಸವನೆ ಹೊಡೆ, ಬೇಸ್‌ಬಾಲ್ ಆಟಗಾರ

**Hindi :** मारना

**Meaning:** strike repeatedly with hard blows.

**Synonyms:** pummel, pound, beat up

**Antonyms:** heal, aid, fix

**Sentence:**

- He was **battered** and falsely imprisoned by the officers.
- I'd like a portion of cod in **batter** and some chips, please.
- A **batter** thin enough to be poured.
- The pancake **batter** is the nice homely type we all know and love.
- The **batter** is an inch in for every foot of height.

### 3. Fallible

**Kannada :** ತಪ್ಪುಬಹುದಾದ, ತಪ್ಪು ಮಾಡುವ, ತಪ್ಪುಬಹುದಾದ

**Hindi :** पतनशील

**Meaning:** capable of making mistakes or being wrong

**Synonyms:** imperfect, flawed, defective

**Antonyms:** perfect, whole, intact

**Sentence:**

- She was a perfectionist who failed to realize that humans are inherently **fallible**.
- We're all **fallible**.
- On the previous time trial, he had been outclassed by Ullrich and suddenly looked **fallible**.
- Experts can be **fallible**.
- But we do the best we can in elections, with limited information and **fallible** judgment.





#### 4. Mollycoddle

**Kannada :** ಹಳೆಯದು , ಅವಹೇಳನಕಾರಿ

**Hindi :** बिगड़ैल

**Meaning:** as into spoil

**Synonyms:** spoil, coddle, pamper

**Antonyms:** discipline, restrain, control

**Sentence:**

- Let's not **mollycoddle** our students!
- The coach started to **mollycoddle** the star player, giving him special treatment before every game.

#### 5. Amplify

**Kannada :** ವರ್ಧಿಸು, ಹೆಚ್ಚಿಸು, ಹಿಗ್ಗಿಸು, ವಿಸ್ತರಿಸು

**Hindi :** विस्तार करना

**Meaning:** To express more fully and in greater detail

**Synonyms:** develop, expand, supplement

**Antonyms:** shorten, condense, summarize

**Sentence:**

- The new manager wants to **amplify** the company.
- Then there is power for the witness to be able to **amplify** his statement.
- The notes **amplify** information contained in the statement.

#### 6. Frisson

**Kannada :** ಉತ್ಸಾಹ ಅಥವಾ ಭಯದ ಹಠಾತ್ ಬಲವಾದ ಭಾವನೆ

**Hindi :** घबराहट

**Meaning:** A pleasurable intense stimulation of the feelings

**Synonyms:** thrill, surprise, fear

**Antonyms:** fearlessness, elate, fright

**Sentence:**

- A **frisson** of alarm ran down my spine.
- I always feel a slight **frisson** when I cross over to the south.
- That would provide the **frisson** of fear which might otherwise be lacking.
- The game has an added **frisson** because of the opposition.
- A **frisson** of excitement.

#### 7. Allegiance

**Kannada :** ನಿಷ್ಠೆ, ಸ್ವಾಮಿ ನಿಷ್ಠೆ, ರಾಜನಿಷ್ಠೆ, ವಿಧೇಯತೆ

**Hindi :** निष्ठा

**Meaning:** loyalty or commitment of a subordinate to a superior or of an individual to a group or cause.

**Synonyms:** loyalty, faithfulness, fidelity

**Antonyms:** disloyalty, faithlessness, falseness

**Sentence:**

- FBI demands its employees absolute **allegiance** to this bureau.
- In addition, students started their day by pledging **allegiance** to the stars and stripes flag.





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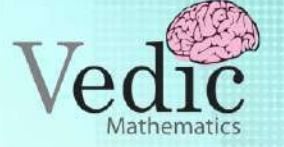
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- You have seen duty and **allegiance** in the determined faces of our soldiers.
- He was rewarded for his unswerving **allegiance** to the party.
- He would be compromised by his party **allegiance**, not to mention his string of directorships.

### 8. Musings

**Kannada** : ನೆನೆ, ನೋಡು, ಓರು, ಚಿಂತಿಸು, ಗಾಢವಾಗಿ ಆಲೋಚಿಸು

**Hindi** : चिंतन

**Meaning**: a period of reflection or thought.

**Synonyms**: meditation, thinking, contemplation

**Antonyms** : unreflective, frivolous, flippant, goofy, scatterbrained, silly, harebrained, thoughtless, flighty

**Sentence**:

- His **musings** were interrupted by the sound of the telephone.
- Trust me, it's for you own good that you never read these confused **musings**.
- Slipstream is all about an old man's **musings** on life, death and God.
- To the more sceptical listener, some of his **musings** may seem a little woolly.
- His **musings** were interrupted by the sound of the telephone.

### 9. Scrumptious

**Kannada** : ಉತ್ತಮವಾದ, ಭರ್ಜರಿಯಾದ, ಸೊಗಸಾದ

**Hindi** : स्वादिष्ट

**Meaning**: very pleasing to the sense of taste

**Synonyms**: delicious, tasteful, yummy

**Antonyms**: distasteful, tasteless, awful

**Sentence**:

- Baked a **scrumptious** chocolate cake.
- From breakfast until dinner, hawkers sell an infinite variety of some of the world's most **scrumptious** snacks.
- And the **scrumptious** recipes at the end are a fine addition to the captivating conclusion.
- The next day, he was pleasantly surprised to find out what a **scrumptious** dessert he had created.

### 10. Quittance

**Kannada** : ಸಾಲ, ಬಾಧ್ಯತೆ ಅಥವಾ ಇತರ ಹೊಣೆಗಾರಿಕೆಯಿಂದ ಬಿಡುಗಡೆ ಅಥವಾ ಬಿಡುಗಡೆಯಾಗಿದೆ

**Hindi** : मुक्ति

**Meaning**: a freeing from an obligation or responsibility

**Synonyms**: release, discharge, exemption





**Antonyms** : debt, disadvantage, dissatisfaction, hindrance, hurt, loss, penalty

**Sentence:**

- The indentured servant obtained a **quittance** from his master stating he was free to leave and was no longer required to work.
- We will acknowledge your title as good, and we will demand of your **quittance** for the above sum, which you will grant us as king of France.
- We were well quit of George Glen and his gang, though the price of the **quittance** was heavy.
