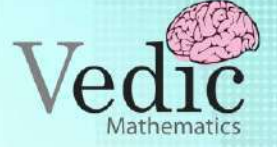

1. Modicum

Kannada : ಅತ್ಯಲ್ಪ, ಕಿಂಚಿತ್ತು, ಸ್ವಲ್ಪ ಪ್ರಮಾಣ

Hindi : अल्पांश

Meaning: a small quantity of a particular thing, especially something considered desirable or valuable.

Synonyms: little bit, small amount, particle

Antonyms : abundance, lot, much money, surplus, world, pile, mass, mountain

Sentence:

- Only a **modicum** of skill is necessary to put the kit together.
- His statement had a **modicum** of truth.
- He thinks he can teach people to achieve success with a **modicum** of effort.
- Have a **modicum** of patience.
- Just five pretty expertly-styled boys with a **modicum** of talent.

2. Scuttlebutt

Kannada : ಪ್ರಕಾರು, ವದಂತಿ, ಬೀದಿ ಮಾತು

Hindi : अफवाह

Meaning: information or opinion that is widely disseminated without any authority or confirmation of accuracy

Synonyms: rumor, gossip, hearsay

Antonym : truth

Sentence:

- According to **scuttlebutt** in the financial markets, the company will be downsizing soon.
- To the millions who greedily gobbled up **scuttlebutt** about her legendary meanness over the years, this is far from a news flash.

3. Impervious

Kannada : ಭೇದಿಸದ

Hindi : अप्रवेश्य

Meaning: impossible to get through or into

Synonyms: dense, impermeable, close

Antonyms: permeable, soft, passable

Sentence:

- Rubber boots are **impervious** to water.
- Despite his best efforts, she remained **impervious** to his charms.
- An **impervious** layer of rock.
- He worked, apparently **impervious** to the heat.
- An **impervious** layer of basaltic clay.

4. Junket

Kannada : ಹಬ್ಬದೂಟ, ಹಣ್ಣುಗಳನ್ನು ಹಾಕಿ, ಕೆಂಪಾಗಿಸಿದ ಒಂದು ವಾದ್ಯ, ಸಿಹಿ ಮಾಡಿದ ಮೊಸರಿಂದ ತಯಾರಿಸಿ ಮೇಲೆ ಕೆನೆ ಸವರಿ

Hindi : भ्रमण

Meaning: an extravagant trip or celebration, in particular one enjoyed by a government official at public expense.

Synonyms: tour, outing, jaunt

Sentence:

- On this particular **junket** he was shopping for real estate.
- A plate of **junket**.
- But the worst thing, by far the worst thing I have ever tasted was **junket**.

5. Antithetical

Kannada : ವಿರೋಧಾತ್ಮಕ

Hindi : विरोधात्मक

Meaning: directly opposed or contrasted; mutually incompatible.

Synonyms: contradictory, contrary, opposite

Antonyms: similar, analogous, like

Sentence:

- Their priorities are **antithetical** to those of environmentalists.
- Without speaking directly to one another, they provide an instructive study of **antithetical** positions on freedoms of expression.
- This is certainly **antithetical** to the interests of the nation.

- The arbitrary state and the society were completely disconnected and **antithetical** to each other.

6. Chagrin

Kannada : ಪರಾಭವ, ಆಶಾಭಂಗ

Hindi : चिढ़

Meaning: distress or embarrassment at having failed or been humiliated.

Synonyms: disappointment, frustration, dissatisfaction

Antonyms: joy, fulfilment, happiness

Sentence:

- Much to his **chagrin**, he did not win the race.
- To my **chagrin**, he was nowhere to be seen.
- Much to his **chagrin**, he was overtaken on the last lap.
- Imagine my **chagrin** when I offered the asking price and was turned down.
- He has adopted the one by the radiator, much to Tess's **chagrin**.

7. Limn

Kannada : ತಿಟ್ಟಬರೆ, ಬಣ್ಣಹಚ್ಚು

Hindi : चित्रित

Meaning: to give a representation or account of in words

Synonyms: describe, depict, portray

Antonyms: misrepresent, falsify

8. Heeded

Kannada : ಗಮನಿಸಿದೆ

Hindi : मान ली

Meaning: pay attention to; take notice of.

Synonyms: followed, noted, obeyed

Antonyms: ignored, disregarded, dismissed

Sentence:

- If he had only **heeded** my warnings, none of this would have happened.
- He should have **heeded** the warnings.
- If only I had **heeded** your advice.
- Thankfully having **heeded** the warning back then I have most of the data backed up.
- Every day lost could mean a child dying because warnings have not been **heeded**.

9. Sedentary

Kannada : ಕುಳಿತುಕೊಳ್ಳುವ, ಕೂರುವ, ಕುಳಿತ, ಆಸೀನ

Hindi : निष्क्रिय

Meaning: (of a person) tending to spend much time seated; somewhat inactive.

Synonyms: dormant, immobile, inanimate

Antonyms: active, mobile, busy

Sentence:

- They led a **sedentary** life after retirement, spending their days in front of the television.
- The contrast with **sedentary** tribes could not, at first sight, be more marked.
- A **sedentary** lifestyle spells bad news for hips and thighs.
- The UK won 30 medals 19, of which were won from a **sedentary** position.
- But we burn off fewer of them because of our more **sedentary** lifestyles.

10. Yammer

Kannada : ಅಳು, ಗೋಳು, ವಿಪರೀತ ಮಾತು

Hindi : परेशान

Meaning: to express dissatisfaction, pain, or resentment usually tiresomely

Synonyms: complain, scream, whine

Antonyms: rejoice, delight, tolerate

Sentence:

- Customers **yammered** on for what seemed like days about the billing mistake.
- From the moment they arrive at the resort, she can't stop **yammering** about the inane details of their lives in North Carolina.
