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1. Tranquillity

Kannada : ನೆಮ್ಮದಿ, ಪ್ರಶಾಂತತೆ

Hindi : शांति

Meaning: the quality or state of being tranquil; calm.

Synonyms: peace, calm, placidity

Antonyms: bustle, commotion, hubbub

Sentence:

- He enjoyed the **tranquillity** of village life.
- All the **tranquillity** he ever knew he enjoyed in his old age.
- Inside St Giles Church, all is cool **tranquillity**.
- Passing cars are the only noise that disturbs the **tranquillity** of rural life.
- Domestic **tranquillity** interested her much more than converting the unfaithful.

2. Fleece

Kannada : ಉಣ್ಣೆ, ತುಪ್ಪಟ, ಸುಲಿ, ಅಪಹರಿಸು, ಲಾಟಿಮಾಡು, ಉಣ್ಣೆ ತೆಗೆ, ತುಪ್ಪಟ ಕತ್ತರಿಸು, ಸುಲಿದುಕೊ

Hindi : फ्रायदा उठाना

Meaning: obtain a great deal of money from (someone), typically by overcharging or swindling them.

Synonyms: swindle, cheat, defraud

Antonyms : undercharge, gutlessness, linger, absolve, calm, overcharge, discharge

Sentence:

- Swindlers who use the telephone to **fleece** senior citizens out of their savings.
- He clutched the ram by two handfuls of thick **fleece**.
- I got soaked when the wind changed, having only my shirt and **fleece** on.
- Then keep sheep out of all streams, or wetland until their **fleece** is dry.
- He put on a **fleece** under his raincoat.

3. Rubble

Kannada : ಅವಶೇಷಗಳು, ಕಲ್ಲಿನ ಅವಶೇಷಗಳು, ಕುಸಿದ ಅವಶೇಷಗಳು

Hindi : मलवा

Meaning: waste or rough fragments of stone, brick, concrete, etc., especially as the debris from the demolition of buildings.

Synonyms: debris, remains, ruins

Antonyms : cleanliness, neatness, possessions, purity, sense, sterility

Sentence:

- Thousands of bodies are still buried under the **rubble**.
- The tower is built of stone **rubble** faced with ashlar.





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- The walls are made of limestone **rubble** and the roof is covered with stone tiles.
- It is built of **rubble** stone with ashlar dressings on a granite plinth.
- The walls are **rubble** and sand, infested with fleas and insects.

4. Dissension

Kannada : ಭಿನ್ನಾಭಿಪ್ರಾಯ, ಒಡಕು, ಅಂತಃಕಲಹ, ಮನಸ್ತಾಪ

Hindi : मतभेद

Meaning: disagreement that leads to discord.

Synonyms: disagreement, dispute, dissent

Antonyms: accord, agreement, concord

Sentence:

- There are signs of **dissension** within the ruling political party.
- The mill was the cause of a **dissension** in 1620.
- These issues caused bitter **dissension** in the party.
- It has suffered since from political **dissension** and civil war.
- Without that measure there will always be arguments, **dissension** and massive problems.

5. Reconciler

Kannada : ರಾಜಿಮಾಡುವವನು, ರಾಜಿಗಾರ, ಪರಿಹರಿಸು, ಒಂದಾಗಿಸು, ಬಗೆಹರಿಸು, ಹೊಂದಿಕೆ ಮಾಡು, ಸಮಾಧಾನ ಪಡಿಸು

Hindi : सुलहकर्ता

Meaning: a person who brings about peace, especially by reconciling adversaries.

Synonyms: conciliator, peacemaker, arbitrator

Antonyms: rabble-rousers, protesters, agitators

Sentence:

- He is the great **reconciler** and harmonizer.
- The respected elder served as a **reconciler** between the feuding families, working tirelessly to bridge their differences and bring peace to the community.
- She has been a **reconciler** of the many differences that she didn't create, but she has the compassion and the resolve, the strength and the courage, to correct,

6. Stave off

Kannada : ದೂರವಿರಿ, ತಡೆ, ತಪ್ಪಿಸು

Hindi : स्थगित करना

Meaning: to assign to a later time





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Synonyms: defer, delay, suspend

Antonyms: act, deal (with), work (on)

Sentence:

- We were hoping to **stave off** these difficult decisions until September.
- The company was able to **stave off** bankruptcy for another few months.

7. Scuffle

Kannada : ಹೊಡೆದಾಟ, ತುಮುಲ, ಕೈಕೈ ಮಿಲಾವಣೆ, ಕಿತ್ತಾಡು, ಬದಿದಾಟ

Hindi : हाथापाई

Meaning: a short, confused fight or struggle at close quarters.

Synonyms: fight, struggle, tussle

Antonyms: truce

Sentence:

- He was involved in a **scuffle** with a photographer.
- He heard the **scuffle** of feet.
- He was knocked to the ground and injured during the **scuffle**.

8. Vamoose

Kannada : ಅವಸರದಿಂದ ಅಥವಾ ತ್ವರಿತವಾಗಿ ಬಿಡಲು, ಹೋಗಿ ಬಾ.

Hindi : जल्दी से निकल जाना

Meaning: depart hurriedly.

Synonyms: depart, exit, walk out

Antonyms: arrive, come,

Sentence:

- We'd better **vamoose** before we're caught.
- Now **vamoose** before you try my patience too far!
- If you're feeling overwhelmed by the loud music and crazy dancing at your friend's party, you might decide to **vamoose** without saying goodbye to her.
- It's getting late, so we had better **vamoose**.
- Khan's group packed fast and **vamoosed** on a small airplane.
- Oh, get out," he sighed, "go on, **vamoose**, you little melt.
- So, as they say in all the old cowboy movies, let's **vamoose**, muchachos!

9. Ambience

Kannada : ವಾತಾವರಣ, ಅಂಬರಿನಂಥ, ಅಂಬರಿನಿಂದ ಮಾಡಿದ

Hindi : माहौल

Meaning: the character and atmosphere of a place.

Synonyms: atmosphere, aura, circumstances

Antonyms : nothingness, nothing, void, emptiness, nihility, nullity, blankness

Sentence:





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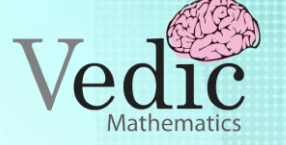
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- The restaurant has a pleasant ambience.
- The town is small and has a certain quiet ambience.
- The relaxed ambience of the cocktail lounge is popular with guests.
- The ambience is one of comfort without luxury.
- She recreates the ambience and complex social networks of the period.

- Had it stopped there, we might rightly regard this talk of crisis as empty **fulmination**.
- She was **fulminating** about the dangers of smoking.
- The editorial **fulminated** against the proposed tax increase.
- Violent discussions had raged over it; it had taken its place as a revolt and held it, despite the **fulmination** of critics and the contempt of academicians.

10. Fulmination

Kannada : ಕಲಹ, ಸಿಡಿ, ಹೊರಚೆಮ್ಮೆ, ಬೊಬ್ಬಿರಿಡು
ಬಯ್ಯು, ಗುಡುಗು

Hindi : निंदा

Meaning: an expression of vehement protest.

Synonyms: protest, objection, complaint

Antonyms: acclaim, applause, commendation

Sentence:

- Players were told they had a right to be spared the foulmouthed **fulmination** of the hockey coach.
- Stewart doesn't deserve such outraged **fulminations**.
- Her complaint took the form of **fulmination**, not reasoned argument.
- He launched into a **fulmination** about how the Democrats were the enemy.
