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1. Brusque

Kannada : ನಯನಾಜುಕಿಲ್ಲದ, ಒರಟಾದ

Hindi : अशिष्ट

Meaning: abrupt or offhand in speech or manner.

Synonyms: abrupt, rude, snappish

Antonyms: polite, courteous, civil

Sentence:

- His secretary was rather **brusque** with me.
- Nor can you claim for a moment that they are rude, or **brusque**.
- His reply was **brusque** and to the point.
- To begin with, at least, he is curt to the point of being **brusque**.
- She could be **brusque** and impatient.

2. Choleric

Kannada : ಕೋಪಿಷ್ಟ, ಬೇಗನೆ ಸಿಟ್ಟು ಬರುವ

Hindi : चिड़चिड़ा

Meaning: bad-tempered or irritable.

Synonyms: irritable, fiery, irascible

Antonyms: genial, affable, cordial

Sentence:

- He was affable at one moment, **choleric** the next.
- My mother had been right to bank on the **choleric** lodger; he was an upwardly mobile man.

- The innkeeper, who was a **choleric** gnome of poor disposition, looked out of the door.

3. Inextricably

Kannada : ಬೇರ್ಪಡಿಸಲಾಗದಂತೆ, ಪಾರಾಗಲಾಗದೆ, ಬಿಡಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳಲಾಗದೆ, ತಪ್ಪಿಸಿಕೊಳ್ಳಲಾಗದೆ

Hindi : अवियोज्य

Meaning: in a way that is impossible to disentangle or separate.

Synonyms: inseparable, indivisible, entangled

Antonyms: separable, explicable

Sentence:

- Physical health is **inextricably** linked to mental health.
- Having brought him up from birth, she has grown **inextricably** attached.
- The two stories are **inextricably** linked.
- For many top executives, golf and business are **inextricably** linked.
- Christmas is **inextricably** interwoven with my notions of home and family.

4. Incipient

Kannada : ಪ್ರಾರಂಭಿಕ, ಪ್ರಥಮಾವಸ್ಥೆಯಲ್ಲಿ, ಆರಂಭದಶೆಯಲ್ಲಿ, ಆರಂಭದಲ್ಲಿ

Hindi : उत्पन्न होनेवाला





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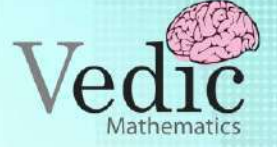
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Meaning: beginning to come into existence

Synonyms: nascent, initial, inchoate

Antonyms: mature, advanced

Sentence:

- The doctors discovered an **incipient** tumour.
- We seemed more like friends than **incipient** lovers.
- An **incipient** black eye.
- He could feel **incipient** anger building up.

5. Telltale

Kannada : ಸುಳಿವು, ಸೂಚನೆ, ಬಹಿರಂಗಪಡಿಸುವ

Hindi : खुलासा

Meaning: revealing, indicating, or betraying something.

Synonyms: indicative, reflective, denoting

Antonyms : Unrevealing, Uninformative, Unexpressive, Hidden, Concealed, Obscure, Ambiguous

Sentence:

- I know you've been eating chocolate because of the **telltale** smudges on your face.
- **Telltale** sound of the fridge being opened could be heard from the next room.
- I noticed the **telltale** signs of someone having been in the flat.

- His feet are swollen and his skin cracked, both **telltale** signs of malnutrition.
- There were **telltale** bloodstains on the suspect's clothing.

6. Punctilious

Kannada : ನಾಜೂಕು ಆಚರಣೆಯ, ಅತಿಸೂಕ್ಷ್ಮ ವಿಷಯದ

Hindi : अति शिष्टाचार

Meaning: showing great attention to detail or correct behavior.

Synonyms: meticulous, conscientious, careful

Antonyms: improper, indecorous

Sentence:

- Joe was always **punctilious** about repaying loans.
- I'm not very **punctilious** about putting links in my blog.
- He was **punctilious** in providing every amenity for his guests.
- As a teenager he was not particularly **punctilious** in following the observances of his religion.
- But the methodology is painstakingly **punctilious** due to the heavy editing involved.





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7. Pragmatic

Kannada : ಪ್ರಾಯೋಗಿಕ, ಲೌಕಿಕ, ರಾಜ್ಯ ವಿಷಯ ಸಂಬಂಧಿ

Hindi : व्यावहारिक

Meaning: dealing with things sensibly and realistically in a way that is based on practical rather than theoretical considerations.

Synonyms: practical, realistic, sensible

Antonyms: idealistic, impractical, unrealistic

Sentence:

- In business, the **pragmatic** approach to problems is often more successful than an idealistic one.
- A **pragmatic** solution may not be the best one in the long term.
- He favoured a **pragmatic** approach to the problem.
- This is a programme that any **pragmatic** centre-right government could be proud of.
- But for all his intellectual gifts, his kingship was essentially **pragmatic**.

8. Roil

Kannada : ಪ್ರಕ್ಷುಬ್ಧಗೊಳಿಸು, ಕಲಕಿಸು, ಕೋಪ ಬರಿಸು, ಚಂಚಲಗೊಳಿಸು

Hindi : क्रोधित करना

Meaning: to make angry

Synonyms: anger, infuriate, enrage

Antonyms: please, relieve, delight

Sentence:

- They were **roiled** by rumours.
- Financial markets have been **roiled** by the banking crisis.
- These words alone have **roiled** the few cities bold enough to utter them.
- For Brown, the project proves an antidote to, or refuge from, the **roiling** agon of our times.

9. Commingle

Kannada : ಒಟ್ಟು ಬೆರೆ, ಒಟ್ಟು ಸೇರು, ಮಿಶ್ರಣ ಮಾಡುವುದು

Hindi : मिलना-जुलना

Meaning: to turn into a single mass or entity that is more or less the same throughout

Synonyms: combine, mix, merge

Antonyms: separate, divide, break up

Sentence:

- I think I'll **commingle** some of these blue flowers with the pink ones.
- He **commingled** his personal funds with money from the business.
- The effect of this there-but-not-there blocking is to **commingle** present, past, and future.





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- The lawsuit claims that Myosin, which is named in the complaint, **commingled** funds with Spellbinder.

10. Dolorous

Kannada : ದುರಾಸೆಯ, ವ್ಯಥೆಗೊಳಿಸುವ, ನೋವುಕೊಡುವ

Hindi : दुःखद

Meaning: feeling or expressing great sorrow or distress.

Synonyms: doleful, sorrowful, sad

Antonyms: joyful, happy, cheerful

Sentence:

- He spoke in a dolorous tone about his past.
- A gently dolorous Bulgarian folk-tune unfolds as a duet.
- A dolorous and repetitive tale of atrocity.
