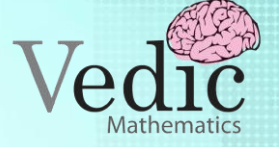

1. Reproach

Kannada : ನಿಂದೆ, ತೆಗಳಿಕೆ, ಭೀಮಾರಿ ಮಾಡು

Hindi : निन्दा

Meaning: A cause of shame

Synonyms: Disgrace, scandal, reflection

Antonyms: Credit, honor, pride

Sentence:

- Your public display of boorish behaviour is a **reproach** to this entire school.
- He gave her a look of **reproach**.
- She gave me a look of **reproach**.
- I let it go without **reproach**.
- The hint of **reproach** in 'omission' may not be quite fair to either of us.

2. Benignant

Kannada : ದಯಾಳು, ಕೃಪಾಳು

Hindi : महरबान

Meaning: Having or marked by sympathy and consideration for others

Synonyms: Compassionate, benevolent, kind

Antonyms: Savage, unkind, vicious

Sentence:

- A **benignant** understanding of the daily struggles of the economically disadvantaged.
- My wife joined me there, and the visit had a very **benignant** effect on her.

- An old man with a **benignant** expression.
- The **benignant** touch of love and beauty.

3. Sequestration

Kannada : ಆಸ್ತಿ ಸ್ವಾಧೀನ, ಮುಟ್ಟುಗೋಲು ಹಾಕಿಕೊಳ್ಳುವುದು

Hindi : ज़बती

Meaning: The state of being alone or kept apart from others

Synonyms: Solitude, isolation, privacy

Antonyms: Society, company, fellowship

Sentence:

- What would you bring for sequestration on a desert island?
- Because of the sequestration of his estate, he received no income from his lands.
- If such court injunctions are ignored, sequestration of trade union assets will follow.
- Sequestration of the company's assets has already taken place.
- Penalties include an unlimited fine, sequestration of property and/or two years imprisonment.

4. Vagaries

Kannada : ಅಸ್ಥಿರತೆ, ಹುಚ್ಚಾಟ, ಚಾಂಚಲ್ಯ, ಮನಬಂದಂತೆ ವರ್ತಿಸುವುದು, ಪರಿಸ್ಥಿತಿಯ ಅಸಾಧಾರಣ ಯಾ ಅನಿರೀಕ್ಷಿತ ಬದಲಾವಣೆ, ಚಿತ್ತವಿಭ್ರಮೆ, ಎಲ್ಲರಂತಿಲ್ಲದ ನಡತೆ, ವಿಚಿತ್ರವರ್ತನೆ

Hindi : अनिश्चितता

Meaning: A sudden impulsive and apparently unmotivated idea or action

Synonyms: Whims, notions, caprices

Antonyms : fancy, quirk, whim, seriousness, dislike, hate, truth, crotchet

Sentence:

- The **vagaries** of a rather eccentric, elderly lady.
- Thanks to the **vagaries** of interest rates, our mortgages can shoot up at will.
- She will also learn first-hand about the **vagaries** of the stock market.
- Transport is too important to be left to the **vagaries** of the market.
- The **vagaries** of the weather.

5. Seclude

Kannada : ಏಕಾಂತ, ದೂರವಾಗಿ, ಒಂಟಿ ಬಾಳೆ, ಬೇರೆಯಾಗಿ, ಪ್ರತ್ಯೇಕವಾಗಿ ಇರಿಸು

Hindi : एकांत

Meaning: To set or keep apart from others

Synonyms: Isolate, separate, segregate

Antonyms: Integrate, join, connect

Sentence:

- The patients will be **secluded** until they are no longer contagious.
- He **secluded** himself in his room to study for the exam.

6. Glee

Kannada : ಉಲ್ಲಾಸ, ಗೆಲುವು, ಹಿಗ್ಗು, ಚಾರಣ ಗೀತೆ

Hindi : उल्लास

Meaning: A mood characterized by high spirits and amusement and often accompanied by laughter

Synonyms: Cheerfulness, merriness, cheer

Antonyms: Sorrow, sadness, unhappiness

Sentence:

- The evident **glee** with which the tabloids report on the misfortunes of celebrities.
- The news filled us with **glee**.
- His face lit up with impish **glee**.
- His phrasing is razor-sharp and should be served with relish and **glee**.
- When she won the lottery she shouted with **glee**.

7. Rescind

Kannada : ರದ್ದುಮಾಡು, ತೆಗೆದುಹಾಕು, ವಜಾಮಾಡು

Hindi : रोक देना

Meaning: To put an end to

Synonyms: Cancel, revoke, abandon

Antonyms: Continue, keep, begin

Sentence:

- The library refused to **rescind** its decision to include the controversial book in its collection.
- The navy **rescinded** its ban on women sailors.
- The company later **rescinded** its offer.

8. Transcendence

Kannada : ಅತೀಂದ್ರಿಯತೆ, ಪಾರಮಾರ್ಥಿಕತೆ

Hindi : श्रेष्ठता

Meaning: The fact or state of being above others in rank or importance

Synonyms: Dominance, superiority, distinction

Antonyms: Insignificance, inferiority, mediocrity

Sentence:

- They long for **transcendence**, but their individual anguish is alleviated by the knowledge that they share their fate.
- The classical tradition affirmed both **transcendence** and immanence.
- By the end of his terrible journey, he embraces the whole 'divine circle' of creation, affirming **transcendence** rather than mortality.

9. Comeuppance

Kannada : ತಕ್ಕ ಶಿಕ್ಷೆ, ಯೋಗ್ಯ ಪ್ರತಿಫಲ

Hindi : फटकारना

Meaning: A punishment or fate that someone deserves.

Synonyms: Punishment, wrath, penalty

Antonyms: Pardon, vindication, indemnity

Sentence:

- That boy was **comeuppance** a lot for his foolishness.
- She will get her **comeuppance** in jail.
- You think there will be moral **comeuppance** but it just gets darker and darker.
- She was against boasting and selfishness, and in favour of bad characters getting their **comeuppance**.
- It won't be long before he gets his **comeuppance**.

10. Bequest

Kannada : ಮೃತ್ಯುಪತ್ರದತ್ತವಾದ ಆಸ್ತಿ, ಕೊಡುಗೆ, ಉಯಿಲು, ಉಯಿಲು ಕೊಡುಗೆ

Hindi : वसीयत

Meaning: Something that is or may be inherited

Synonyms: Inheritance, legacy, gift

Antonyms : disown, receive, receipt, debt, disadvantage, dispossess, accept, blockage

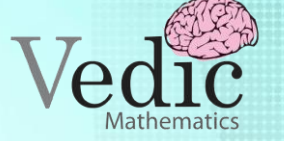
