


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1. Perused

Kannada: ಅವಲೋಕಿಸಿದ, ಗಮನವಿಟ್ಯು ಓದುವುದು ಅಥವಾ ಸವಿಸ್ತಾರವಾಗಿ ಪರಿಶೀಲಿಸುವುದು

Hindi : ध्यान से पढना

Meaning: read (something), typically in a thorough or careful way.

Synonyms: read, reviewed, studied

Antonyms : Skimmed, Overlooked, Ignored, Neglected, Glanced, Disregarded, Missed, Avoided

Sentence:

- After breakfast___ he perused the newspapers.
- He **perused** the newspaper over breakfast.
- Thank you for taking the time to peruse this note all the way to the end.
- With Oct 2023 in the books, here are some facts to **peruse** through.
- So, **peruse** the roundup and pick a few to check out over the next few months.

2. Lucent

Kannada: ಪ್ರಕಾಶಮಾನ, ಪ್ರಕಾಶಿಸುವ, ಪ್ರಕಾಶಕ, ಹೊಳೆಯುವ, ಪಾರ ಪಾರದೀಪಕ

Hindi : प्रकाशमान

Meaning: glowing with or giving off light. Synonyms: luminous, glowing, shining

Antonyms: dim, dusky, dark

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Sentence:

- The moon was a lucent orb in the cloudless autumn sky.
- The moon was a lucent orb in the cloudless autumn sky.
- The night sky was illuminated by a **lucent**, silver moon.
- His ideas were **lucent** and easy to follow.
- She saw a faint, lucent glow coming from the distant house.
- We're just friends, walking through Leningrad in the lucent dusk.

3. Milieus

ಪರಿಸರ. Kannada ಸಾಮಾಜಿಕ ಸನ್ಶಿವೇಶ ವಾತಾವರಣ, ಅಥವಾ (ಸಾಮಾಜಿಕ ಅಥವಾ ಭೌತಿಕ)

Hindi : परिवेश

Meaning: the circumstances, conditions, or objects by which one is surrounded

Synonyms: environments, surroundings, contexts

Antonyms: Isolation, Solitude, Insularity, Seclusion, Desert, Wilderness, Vacancy, Void

Sentence:

- He grew up in a military **milieu**.
- The author's book was not only a biography but also a detailed chronicle of the social and cultural **milieu** in which the artist lived and worked.

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


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4. Debilitating

ದುರ್ಬಲಗೊಳಿಸುವುದು, Kannada ಶಕ್ಕಿಗುಂದಿಸು, ದುರ್ಬಲ ಮಾಡು, ನಿತ್ರಾಣಗೊಳಿಸು, ಅಥವಾ ಕುಗ್ಗಿಸು

Hindi : दुर्बल करना

Meaning: making someone very weak and infirm.

Synonyms: weakening, enfeebling, enervating

Antonyms: strengthening, energizing, fortifying

Sentence:

- Huge debts are debilitating their economy.
- The excruciating pain from the injury made it a debilitating condition that kept him from walking for months.
- The debilitating humidity threatened the old books in their new, tropical home.
- Many people experience debilitating fatigue after a serious illness.
- The team was weakened debilitating flu that spread through their locker room.

5. Cantankerous

ಜಗಳಗಂಟಿ. Kannada ಕಿತ್ತಾಡುವ ಸಿಡುಕಿನ, ಕಲಹ ಪ್ರಿಯ, ಸ್ವಭಾವದ, ರೇಗುವ

Hindi : झगड़ालू

Meaning: bad-tempered, argumentative, and uncooperative.

bad-tempered, irascible. Synonyms: crotchety

Antonyms: amiable, pleasant, friendly Sentence:

- He's getting a bit cantankerous in his old age.
- The cantankerous old man did not want children to play on his lawn.
- He gets cantankerous, even downright nasty, in response to lazy assumptions or incorrect facts.
- She has a lean tone that can be affectingly lyrical one moment and abruptly **cantankerous** the next.

6. Excursion

Kannada: ವಿಹಾರ, ತಿರುಗಾಟ, ಪ್ರಯಾಣ Hindi: भ्रमण Wate Limited

Meaning: a short journey or trip, especially one engaged in as a leisure activity.

Synonyms: tour, jaunt, trip

Antonyms: Stay, Residence, Stationary, Halt, Immobility, Rest, Stop, Inaction

Sentence:

- We went on an excursion to the city.
- The family went on a day **excursion** to the coast for a picnic and some fun at the beach.
- We signed up for an **excursion** to the ancient ruins as an optional tour.

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- The company organized a short boat **excursion** to a nearby island for the employees.
- Our drive home was extended by a spontaneous excursion to a scenic overlook.
- His brief **excursion** into politics ended after one term.

7. Encompassed

ಸುತ್ತುವರಿದ, Kannada : ಆವರಿಸಿದೆ, ಒಳಗೊಂಡಿರುವ ಅಥವಾ ಸಂಪೂರ್ಣವಾಗಿ ಆವರಿಸಿರುವ

Hindi : घेरना

Meaning: surround and have or hold within.

Synonyms: surround, enclose, circumscribe Antonyms: exposed, denuded Sentence:

- The enemy encompassed the city.
- The sprawling park encompassed a diverse range of activities, picnicking and jogging to rock climbing and boating.
- The job **encompassed** a wide range of responsibilities, from managing social media to coordinating events.
- The exhibition **encompassed** artifacts from various ancient civilizations, spanning thousands of years.
- The new law **encompassed** regulations on everything from emissions to fuel efficiency.

8. Legible

ಸೃಷ್ಟವಾದ, ಓದಬಲ್ಲ, Kannada ಸುಲಭವಾಗಿ ಓದಲಾಗುವ, ಸುಲಭವಾಗಿ ಒದಬಲ್ಲ

Hindi : पढने योग्य

Meaning: (of handwriting or print) clear enough to read.

Synonyms: readable, comprehensible, clear

Antonyms: incomprehensible, incoherent, obscure

Sentence:

- The original typescript is scarcely legible.
- The document is not legible.
- The line of the back of the legs became much more **legible** and the young man grew taller by an inch.
- The exact dates of his birth and death were no longer legible.
- But even in that scenario, the small white text was still quite legible.

9. Ever and anon


Kannada : ಕೆಲವೊಮ್ಮೆ, ಕಾಲಕಾಲಕ್ಕೆ ಕೂಗಿನಿಂದ ಮೌನ ಗಿಬ್ಬನ್ನ ಮುರಿಯುತ್ತದೆ.

Hindi : कभी-कभी

Meaning: on some occasions

Synonyms: sometimes, now, occasionally Antonyms: frequently, commonly, usually

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Sentence:

- He loses his temper ever and anon.
- The old man would, ever and anon, look wistfully at the sea, a habit from his seafaring days.
- Ever and anon, a distant rumble of thunder could be heard, though no storm was in sight.
- She had been warned against pickpockets, for, ever and anon, she would clutch her purse nervously.
- Though he tried to stay busy, ever and anon he would find his thoughts drifting to the past.

- Despite the serious topic, the comedian **prattled** on about silly, inconsequential things, and the audience loved it.
- The old man **prattled** to the younger generation about his life experiences, sometimes repeating the same stories.
- We tried to have a serious conversation, but she just continued to **prattle** about her vacation plans.

10. Prattle

Kannada: ಬಡಬಡಿಸು, ಹರಟೆ ಹೊಡೆ,

ಗೊಣಗು

Hindi: बकवास करना

Meaning: unintelligible or meaningless talk

Synonyms: babble, nonsense, chatter

Antonyms: Silence, Quiet, Hush, Stillness, Speechlessness, Reticence, Taciturnity,

Muteness

Sentence:

- Don't **prattle** about your theory. You must practice it and prove it.
- The children's cheerful **prattle** filled the room with a joyful noise as they played.
- He was tired of listening to his boss **prattle** on about his golf game.

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
