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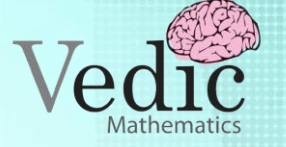
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1. Forgo

Kannada : ಬಿಟ್ಟುಬಿಡಿ, ಬಳಸದಿರು, ವರ್ಜಿಸು, ಉಪಯೋಗಿಸದಿರು

Hindi : त्यागना

Meaning: to resist the temptation of

Synonyms: avoid, refuse, deny

Antonyms: submit surrender accept

Sentence:

- Do not, for one repulse, **forgo** the purpose that you resolved to effort.
- I think I'll **forgo** the soup and go straight to the main course.
- They may **forgo** their lunch break or decide to work late.
- She wanted to **forgo** the tea and leave while they could.
- He chose to **forgo** the chance of a knighthood.

2. Calumny

Kannada : ಸುಳ್ಳು ಆಪಾದನೆ, ದ್ವೇಷಪೂರಿತವಾದ ಸುಳ್ಳು

Hindi : निंदा

Meaning: the making of false statements that damage another's reputation

Synonyms: defaming, criticism, libelling

Antonyms: praise, applause, commendation

Sentence:

- He was the victim of **calumny**.

- I'm sure both parts of this assertion are mere **calumny**.
- It would be a **calumny** on the reputation of that great man to suggest it.
- That's her privilege, but I shan't forget the **calumny** in a hurry.
- As for my getting more and more curmudgeonly, that is an outright **calumny**.

3. Fallible

Kannada : ತಪ್ಪುಬಹುದಾದ, ತಪ್ಪು ಮಾಡುವ, ತಪ್ಪುಬಹುದಾದ

Hindi : पतनशील

Meaning: capable of making mistakes or being wrong

Synonyms: imperfect, flawed, defective

Antonyms: perfect, whole, intact

Sentence:

- She was a perfectionist who failed to realize that humans are inherently **fallible**.
- We're all **fallible**.
- On the previous time trial, he had been outclassed by Ullrich and suddenly looked **fallible**.
- Experts can be **fallible**.
- But we do the best we can in elections, with limited information and **fallible** judgment.





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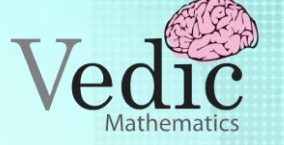
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4. Mollycoddle

Kannada : ಹಳೆಯದು , ಅವಹೇಳನಕಾರಿ

Hindi : बिगड़ैल

Meaning: as into spoil

Synonyms: spoil, coddle, pamper

Antonyms: discipline, restrain, control

Sentence:

- Let's not **mollycoddle** our students!
- The coach started to **mollycoddle** the star player, giving him special treatment before every game.

5. Accolades

Kannada : ಪುರಸ್ಕಾರಗಳು

Hindi : प्रशंसा मिलना

Meaning: a formal expression of praise

Synonyms: honors, tributes, applauses

Antonyms: indictments, condemnations, denunciations

Sentence:

- Already, the program has won **accolades** for bringing investment to poor neighborhoods of Knoxville.
- It would not surprise me if she wins **accolades** and awards.
- He has won a lot of **accolades** during his career.
- The 16th century inn has won numerous **accolades**.

- The hotel has won numerous **accolades**.

6. Plenitude

Kannada : ಸಮೃದ್ಧಿ, ಸಮಗ್ರತೆ, ಪೂರ್ಣತೆ

Hindi : प्रचुरता

Meaning: a considerable amount

Synonyms: loads, plenty, ton

Antonyms: loads, plenty, ton

Sentence:

- there's a **plenitude** of natural beauty in the state
- An ancient Celtic god thought to bring a **plenitude** of wealth or food.
- The **plenitude** of the Pope's powers.
- But does this aesthetic **plenitude** really help?

7. Extraneous

Kannada : ಬಾಹ್ಯ, ಹೊರಗಿನ ಬಾಹ್ಯ, ಹೊರಗಿನಿಂದ ಬಂದ

Hindi : बाहरी

Meaning: not being a vital part of or belonging to something

Synonyms: irrelevant, external, extrinsic

Antonyms: inherent, intrinsic, innate

Sentence:

- the architect's streamlined modern style shuns any sort of **extraneous** ornamentation.





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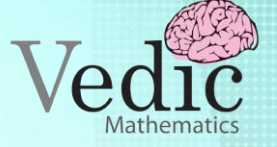
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- When the transmitter pack is turned off no **extraneous** noise is heard.
- Foreign coins and other **extraneous** objects go to one side.
- One is obliged to wade through many pages of **extraneous** material.
- All right, then - let me reiterate my initial post, with all **extraneous** material removed.

8. Regale

Kannada : ಸೊಮ್ಮುಗೊಳಿಸು, ಹಬ್ಬದೂಟ ಕೊಡಿಸು, ಮೃಷ್ಟಾನ್ನ ಭೋಜನ ನೀಡು, ನಗಿಸು

Hindi : दावत

Meaning: a large fancy meal often accompanied by ceremony or entertainment

Synonyms: dinner, banquet, feast

Antonyms : bore, tire, anger, annoy, depress, disappoint, disturb, frustrate, pain, refuse, upset

Sentence:

- He invited all his friends to a **regale** tonight
- Over dinner I'll **regale** you with stories about all the great singers.
- She was supposed to be trying to draw him out, not **regale** him with her life story.
- She hoped she'd remember enough to **regale** Matthew with over lunch.

9. Dubious

Kannada : ಸಂಶಯಾಸ್ಪದ, ಅಸ್ಪಷ್ಟ, ಅಸ್ಪಷ್ಟ, ಮಸಕಾದ

Hindi : संदिग्ध

Meaning: giving good reason for being doubted, questioned, or challenged

Synonyms: questionable, suspicious, doubtful

Antonyms: certain, indisputable, unquestionable

Sentence:

- The firm was accused of **dubious** accounting practices.
- I'm very **dubious** about letting them to go on their own.
- 'how do you feel about her suggestion?' — 'I'm still rather **dubious** about it'.
- I was rather **dubious** about the whole idea.
- It holds the **dubious** distinction of being the world's most bombed hotel.

10. Approbation

Kannada : ಅನುಮೋದನೆ, ಒಪ್ಪಿಗೆ, ಅನುಮತಿ

Hindi : प्रशंसा

Meaning: an acceptance of something as satisfactory

Synonyms: blessing, satisfaction, accession





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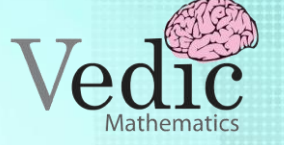
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Antonyms: disapproval, refusal, rejection

Sentence:

- He tasted the wine of audience **approbation**.
- A term of **approbation**.
- They deserve credit, **approbation**, applause and salutations for this achievement.
