

- He has won a lot of accolades during his career.

9. Dubious

ಮಸಕಾದ

Hindi : संदिग्ध

Meaning: giving good reason for being

doubted, questioned, or challenged

Synonyms: questionable, suspicious,

doubtful

Antonyms: indisputable, certain, unquestionable

Sentence:

- The firm was accused of dubious accounting practices.
- I'm very dubious about letting them to go on their own.
- 'how do feel about her vou Synonyms: dinner, banquet, feast suggestion?' — 'I'm still rather dubious about it'.
 - I was rather **dubious** about the whole idea.
 - It holds the **dubious** distinction of being the world's most bombed hotel.

10. Approbation

Kannada : ಅನುಮೋದನೆ, ಒಪ್ಪಿಗೆ, ಅನುಮತಿ

Hindi : प्रशंसा

Meaning: an acceptance of something as satisfactory

Synonyms: blessing, satisfaction, accession


