1. Fob

Kannada : ವಂಚಿಸು, ಮೋಸಮಾಡು, ಕೈಕೊಡು

Hindi : धोखा देना

Meaning: deceitfully attempt to satisfy someone by making excuses or giving them something inferior.

Synonyms: deceive, trick, deter

Antonyms : Credit, Praise, Commend, Approve, Accept, Compliment, Honor, Trust, Acknowledge, Respect

Sentence:

- Don't try to **fob** me off with excuses.
- Don't let them **fob** you off with false promises.
- We operate on a **FOB** Origin basis, meaning the buyer assumes costs and risks once the goods leave the port.

2. Cunning

Kannada : ಕುತಂತ್ರ, ಕುಯುಕ್ತಿ

Hindi : चालाकी

Meaning: having or showing skill in achieving one's ends by deceit or evasion.

Synonyms: wily, devious, guileful

Antonyms: sincerity, ingenuousness

Sentence:

- He's a **cunning** old fox.
- She devised a **cunning** plan to fake her own death.
- A **cunning** look came into his eyes.

- He's a **cunning** man who says one thing but does another.
- He was **cunning** and smart and always thought ahead.

3. Contravention

Kannada : ಉಲ್ಲಂಘನೆ

Hindi : उल्लंघन

Meaning: a failure to uphold the requirements of law, duty, or obligation

Synonyms: violation, breach, offence

Antonyms: observance, respecting, upholding

Sentence:

- Sending the troops was a **contravention** of the treaty.
- This effort was in direct **contravention** of a law passed by Congress that forbade the delivery of lethal weapons of war to the Contras.
- Ben asked, in direct **contravention** of the mantra that everything is necessarily the best in the best of all possible leagues.

4. Vertiginous

Kannada : ಸುತ್ತುವ, ತಿರುಗುವ, ತಲೆಸುತ್ತು ಬೀಳುವಂತಾಗುವ

Hindi : चक्कर आना

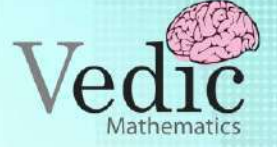

Meaning: having or causing a whirling sensation; liable to failing

Synonyms: giddy, dizzy, woozy

Antonyms: steady, stable, clearheaded

Sentence:

- 3 – D effect is likely to leave some audience members feeling **vertiginous**.
- The stakes here, the film screams at you, are **vertiginous**.
- The Sandman' is complex to the point of labyrinthine, non-linear to the point of **vertiginous**.
- The bridge wobbles a bit with each step and has **vertiginous** canyon views.

5. Feisty

Kannada : ಉಗ್ರವಾದ, ಸಿಡುಕುವ, ಕೆರಳುವ, ರೇಗುವ

Hindi : आक्रामक

Meaning: feeling or displaying eagerness to fight

Synonyms: aggressive, militant, hostile

Antonyms: peaceful, peaceable, nonaggressive

Sentence:

- At 66, he was as **feisty** as ever.
- She was a vibrant, lively and **feisty** woman who had an extremely positive attitude towards life.
- She was a really **feisty**, fearless woman who loved to laugh.

- In so many ways the **feisty** young man from Dunblane is a dichotomy.

6. Infamy

Kannada : ಅಪಖ್ಯಾತಿ, ಕುಖ್ಯಾತಿ, ಕೆಟ್ಟ ಹೆಸರು, ಕುಪ್ರಸಿದ್ಧಿ, ಅಪಕೀರ್ತಿ

Hindi : बदनामी

Meaning: the state of being well known for some bad quality or deed.

Synonyms: disgrace, shame, ignominy

Antonyms: respect, honor, esteem

Sentence:

- Traitors are held in **infamy**.
- He never escaped the **infamy** his crimes had earned him.
- The raid would live in **infamy** as the Night of the Gliders.
- Well, there's been a lot of **infamy** over the last 15 years.
- But the team wasn't alone in steering clear of his **infamy**.

7. Overkill

Kannada : ಅತಿಯಾಗಿ ಕೊಲ್ಲು, ಅತಿವಿನಾಶ

Hindi : अति करना

Meaning: the state or an instance of going beyond what is usual, proper, or needed

Synonyms: surplus, excess, overflow

Antonyms: deficiency, deficit, insufficiency

8. Ephemeral

Kannada : ಅಲ್ಪಕಾಲಿಕ

Hindi : अल्पकालिक

Meaning: lasting for a very short time.

Synonyms: brief, short, little

Antonyms: eternal, lasting, enduring

Sentence:

- Fashion is by nature **ephemeral**.
- Fashions are **ephemeral**: new ones regularly drive out the old.
- Works of more than **ephemeral** interest.
- Bulbs have a very different life strategy from **ephemeral** weeds.

9. Letup

Kannada : ವಿರಾಮ, ನಿಲ್ಲಿಸುವುದು, ಅವಧಿ, ಬದಲಾವಣೆ

Hindi : कम होना

Meaning: a usually gradual decrease in the pace or level of activity of something

Synonyms: slowdown, decline, deceleration

Antonyms: acceleration, quickening, hastening

Sentence:

- The downpour continued for hours without **letup**.
- There was no **letup** even as Carlisle emptied his bench in the second half.
- End of carousel In the hours before the pause was to begin, there was no sign in Gaza of a **letup** in violence.
- But soldiers on the front line do not foresee any **letup**.

10. Congruity

Kannada : ಸಾಮರಸ್ಯ, ಒಪ್ಪಿಗೆ, ಸಾಮರಸ್ಯ, ಸಮನ್ವಯ, ಅಥವಾ ಸೂಕ್ತತೆ

Hindi : समानता

Meaning: a point which two or more things share in common

Synonyms: similarity, resemblance, commonality

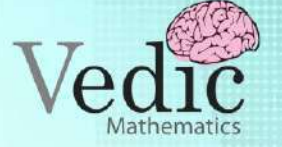
