3. Startling

Synonyms: surprising, amazing, shocking unsurprising, Antonyms: common, ordinary

- She had **startling** blue eyes.
- He had golden tanned skin, startling blue eyes and short blonde hair.
- But in **startling** contrast, let me show you another side of the worm's nature.

Synonyms: punishment, wrath, penalty Antonyms: forgiveness, release, pardon Sentence:

- think there will be moral comeuppance but it just gets darker and darker.
- She was against boasting and selfishness, and in favour of bad characters getting their comeuppance.



- Tree shrew lavatories: a novel nitrogen sequestration strategy in a tropical pitcher plant.
- Carbon **sequestration** in basalt has been studied as a means of removing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere.




