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1. Abnegate

Kannada : ನಿರಾಕರಿಸಲು ಅಥವಾ ನಿರಾಕರಿಸಲು (ಕೆಲವು ಹಕ್ಕುಗಳು, ಅನುಕೂಲಗಳು, ಇತ್ಯಾದಿ), ತಿರಸ್ಕರಿಸು, ತ್ಯಜಿಸು, ಬಿಟ್ಟುಕೊಡಲು, ಬಿಟ್ಟುಕೊಡು

Hindi : त्याग करना

Meaning: to give up (as a position of authority) formally

Synonyms: abdicate, deny, abandon

Antonyms: assume, claim, appropriate

Sentence:

- What emergency things that let persons **abrogate** their lives?
- It is not the intention of the Myanmar government to apportion blame or to **abnegate** responsibility.
- We condemn all human rights violations and unlawful violence. Even having the right blueprint means little if your players **abnegate** basic responsibility as feebly as Mustafi did.

2. Persuade

Kannada : ಮನವೊಲಿಸಿ, ಹಿಂಬಾಲಿಸು, ಮನವೊಲಿಕೆ, ಒಡಂಬಡಿಸು, ಖಾತರಿಗೊಳಿಸು

Hindi : राजी करना

Meaning: To cause (someone) to agree with a belief or course of action by using arguments or earnest request

Synonyms: convince, satisfy, bring

Antonyms: deter, discourage, dissuade

Sentence:

- I failed in my attempt to **persuade** her.
- How did you **persuade** him to give you the money?
- He did everything he could to **persuade** the police that he was the robber.
- With his charm, he can easily **persuade** people.
- If the moral case won't **persuade** everyone, perhaps the practical case will.

3. Incertitude

Kannada : ಅನಿಶ್ಚಿತತೆ ಅಥವಾ ಅನಿಶ್ಚಿತತೆಯು ಅಪೂರ್ಣ ಅಥವಾ ಅಪರಿಚಿತ ಮಾಹಿತಿಯನ್ನು ಒಳಗೊಂಡಿರುವ ಸಂದರ್ಭಗಳನ್ನು ಸೂಚಿಸುತ್ತದೆ.

Hindi : अनिश्चितता

Meaning: a feeling or attitude that one does not know the truth, truthfulness, or trustworthiness of someone or something

Synonyms: doubt, skepticism, suspicion

Antonyms: belief, conviction, trust

Sentence:

- Some schools broke down under the stresses of policy **incertitude**
- And yet the actor spent much of a recent conversation candidly admitting to ambivalence and **incertitude**.





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- But underneath the skepticism, something else nagged at me: the sense that my **incertitude** was a metastasis of our jittery, gaslit world, where baseline reality is increasingly in dispute.

4. Mutinous

Kannada : ದಂಗೆಕೋರ, ದಂಗೆಯೇಳುವ, ಬಂಡುಕೋರ, ಬಂಡಾಯ ಮಾಡುವ

Hindi : विद्रोही

Meaning: taking part in a rebellion

Synonyms: traitorous, rebellious, revolutionary

Antonyms: loyal, constant, steadfast

Sentence:

- Vowed that he would someday see the **mutinous** crew hang.
- The crew turned **mutinous**.
- Most naval officers had either fled or been murdered by their **mutinous** crews.
- I will not tolerate this **mutinous** behaviour!
- Antoinette looked **mutinous**, but she obeyed.

5. Ransack

Kannada : ದರೋಡೆಕೋರರು, ಬೆದಕು, ಕಾಲಂಕಷವಾಗಿ ಹುಡುಕು, ಶೋಧಿಸು, ಕೊಳ್ಳೆ ಹೊಡೆ

Hindi : खोजना

Meaning: to look through (as a place) carefully or thoroughly in an effort to find or discover something

Synonyms: search, find, scour

Antonyms: hide, lose, abandon

Sentence:

- They **ransacked** the whole classroom for their basketball.
- The intruders grabbed 2,000 as they **ransacked** the house.
- She **ransacked** her house hunting for the ticket, before remembering she still had the play slip.
- A library had been **ransacked** and shops looted.
- He was allowed home after one night, only to find his house had been **ransacked** in his absence.

6. Vicious

Kannada : ದುಷ್ಟ, ದುರಾಚಾರದ, ದುರಭ್ಯಾಸದ, ಅನ್ಯೈತಿಕ

Hindi : भयंकर

Meaning: Extreme in degree, power, or effect

Synonyms: intense, intensive, fierce

Antonyms: moderate, weak, soft

Sentence:





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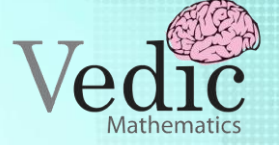
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- A **vicious** winter storm ripped through the region
- The dog was **vicious** and likely to bite.
- What had made me smile was his **vicious** and vile bigotry.
- As nations become more corrupt and **vicious**, they have more need of masters.
- Snow wolves were **vicious**, bloodthirsty wolves that roamed the forest.

7. Squalid

Kannada : ದರಿದ್ರ, ತುಚ್ಛ, ಕೊಳಕಾದ, ಹೊಲಸಾದ, ಮಲಿನವಾದ, ಅಪ್ರಿಯಸ್ವರೂಪದ

Hindi : गंदा

Meaning: severely lacking in cleanliness

Synonyms: dusty, muddy, dirty

Antonyms: dusty, muddy, dirty

Sentence:

- Many prisons, even today, are overcrowded and **squalid** places.
- I was shocked by the **squalid** state of the room.
- Many live in **squalid** camps and eke out a living as day labourers.
- I visited the **squalid** slums on the outskirts of the city.
- The peasants lived in **squalid** conditions.

8. Unfruitful

Kannada : ಫಲಪ್ರದವಾಗದ, ವ್ಯರ್ಥ, ಲಾಭದಾಯಕವಲ್ಲದ, ನಿಷ್ಫಲವಾದ

Hindi : निष्फल

Meaning: not able to produce fruit or offspring

Synonyms: sterile, barren, fruitless

Antonyms: fruitful, fertile, productive

Sentence:

- They have been **unfruitful** in their efforts.
- Her time at the Manhattan School of Music was similarly **unfruitful**, and she quit.
- The meeting was **unfruitful**.
- Single trees are often **unfruitful**, and mixed planting is desirable.

9. Scrumptious

Kannada : ಉತ್ತಮವಾದ, ಭರ್ಜರಿಯಾದ, ಸೊಗಸಾದ

Hindi : स्वादिष्ट

Meaning: very pleasing to the sense of taste

Synonyms: delicious, tasteful, yummy

Antonyms: distasteful, tasteless, awful

Sentence:

- Baked a **scrumptious** chocolate cake.





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- From breakfast until dinner, hawkers sell an infinite variety of some of the world's most **scrumptious** snacks.
- And the **scrumptious** recipes at the end are a fine addition to the captivating conclusion.
- The next day, he was pleasantly surprised to find out what a **scrumptious** dessert he had created.

- We were well quit of George Glen and his gang, though the price of the **quittance** was heavy.

10. Quittance

Kannada : ಸಾಲ, ಬಾಧ್ಯತೆ ಅಥವಾ ಇತರ ಹೊಣೆಗಾರಿಕೆಯಿಂದ ಬಿಡುಗಡೆ ಅಥವಾ ಬಿಡುಗಡೆಯಾಗಿದೆ

Hindi : मुक्ति

Meaning: a freeing from an obligation or responsibility

Synonyms: release, discharge, exemption

Antonyms : debt, disadvantage, dissatisfaction, hindrance, hurt, loss, penalty

Sentence:

- The indentured servant obtained a **quittance** from his master stating he was free to leave and was no longer required to work.
- We will acknowledge your title as good, and we will demand of your **quittance** for the above sum, which you will grant us as king of France.
