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1. Disparage

Kannada : ಅವಹೇಳನ, ಅಗೌರವ ತರು, ಕೆಟ್ಟಹೆಸರು ತರು, ಅಪಕೀರ್ತಿ ತರು

Hindi : उपेक्षा करना

Meaning: regard or represent as being of little worth

Synonyms: belittle, denigrate, deprecate

Antonyms: acclaim, applaud, exalt

Sentence:

- He never missed an opportunity to **disparage** his competitors.
- You **disparage** a woman's driving or mock her way of problem-solving.
- That is not in any way to **disparage** his two competitors.
- He never missed an opportunity to **disparage** his competitors.

2. Affluent

Kannada : ಶ್ರೀಮಂತ, ಸಮೃದ್ಧ

Hindi : धनी

Meaning: having a great deal of money; wealthy

Synonyms: wealthy, rich, prosperous

Antonyms: unaffluent, bankrupt, indebted

Sentence:

- Cigarette smoking used to be commoner among **affluent** people.
- They live in an **affluent** suburb.

- It's a very **affluent** area and I like pretending I live there!.
- The programme showed the sort of **affluent** lifestyle most of us can only aspire to.
- They are obviously very **affluent**.

3. Demoralize

Kannada : ನಿರುತ್ಸಾಹಗೊಳಿಸು, ಸ್ಥೈರ್ಯಗೆಡಿಸು, ನೀತಿಗೆಡಿಸು

Hindi : नैतिक करना

Meaning: cause (someone) to lose confidence or hope

Synonyms: dishearten, dispirit, deject

Antonyms: cheer, gladden, animate

Sentence:

- Their rejection of the treaty has **demoralized** the diplomatic community.
- The only way to win the war would be to **demoralize** the enemy.
- Plays like that are huge for us and **demoralizing** for the other team.
- Things are at white heat in all that part of the country and the citizens are almost **demoralized**.
- The show offered a way out of the **demoralizing** trap of belonging to the electorate.





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4. Reprimands

Kannada : ಛೇಮಾರಿ ಹಾಕುತ್ತಾರೆ, ಗದರಿಕೆ

Hindi : फटकार

Meaning: a rebuke, especially an official one

Synonyms: rebuke, reproof, admonishment

Antonyms: citations, commendations, endorsements

Sentence:

- The golfer received a **reprimand** for a breach of rules.
- His boss gave him a severe **reprimand** for being late.
- I received one written **reprimand** in three years.
- He received a verbal **reprimand** for unsatisfactory performance.

5. Suitor

Kannada : ವರ, ಅಂಕೆಗಾರ, ಮನವಿಗಾರ, ಕನ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿ, ಮದುವೆಗಾಗಿ ಒಬ್ಬ ಕನ್ಯೆಯನ್ನು ಅನುಸರಿಸುತ್ತಿರುವ ವ್ಯಕ್ತಿ, ವಿವಾಹಾರ್ಥಿ, ವಧೂವರಕಾರ್ಥಿ

Hindi : प्रेमी

Meaning: a man who pursues a relationship with a particular woman, with a view to marriage

Synonyms: admirer, beau, wooer

Antonyms: enemy

Sentence:

- He was her most persistent **suitor**, and she eventually agreed to marry him.
- By then though Abbey may already have got married to its Scottish **suitor**.
- She decided to marry her **suitor**.
- The company agreed to negotiate with its **suitor**.
- Private equity firm Permira is often touted as a possible **suitor**.

6. Stashing

Kannada : ಗುಪ್ತ ಅಥವಾ ರಹಸ್ಯ ಸ್ಥಳದಲ್ಲಿ (ಏನನ್ನಾದರೂ) ಸುರಕ್ಷಿತವಾಗಿ ಸಂಗ್ರಹಿಸಲು

Hindi : छिपाना

Meaning: store (something) safely and secretly in a specified place

Synonyms: hide, store, secrete

Antonyms: handing out, casting

Sentence:

- Their wealth had been **stashed** away in Swiss banks.
- The stolen pictures were **stashed** (away) in a warehouse.
- He needed a place to **stash** some cash.





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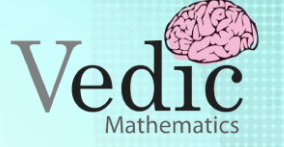
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7. Hooliganism

Kannada : ಗೂಂಡಾಗಿರಿ, ಪುಂಡತನ

Hindi : उपद्रव

Meaning: violent or rowdy behavior by young troublemakers, typically in a gang

Synonyms: evil, immorality, sin

Antonyms: goodness

Sentence:

- The propensity to **hooliganism** is inherent in every society.
- There was much talk about Scottish police requiring more powers to tackle **hooliganism**.
- An act of mindless **hooliganism**.
- Furious residents called for tougher police measures in a desperate bid to combat **hooliganism**.
- Italy's sports minister has demanded that clubs take immediate steps to tackle **hooliganism**.

8. Grievances

Kannada : ಕುಂದುಕೊರತೆಗಳು, ಸಂಕಟ

Hindi : शिकायत

Meaning: a real or imagined wrong or other cause for complaint or protest, especially unfair treatment

Synonyms: injustice, unjust act, wrong

Antonyms: acclaim, applauses, praises

Sentence:

- Their main **grievance** was that they had not received their pitifully low pay.
- Is this really the time to air your **grievances**?
- A website which enabled staff to air their **grievances**.
- The correct procedure for **grievances** must be followed.
- Three pilots have filed **grievances** against the company.

9. Brute

Kannada : ವಿವೇಚನಾರಹಿತ, ಬುದ್ಧಿಯಿಲ್ಲದ, ಅಸಭ್ಯ, ಒರಟ, ಪಶು, ಮೃಗ

Hindi : पशु

Meaning: a savagely violent person or animal

Synonyms: beast, monster, merciless

Antonyms: humane, kind, kind-hearted

Sentence:

- His father was a drunken **brute**.
- That dog looks a real **brute**.
- So, not life or death here - just a **brute** of a golf course.
- A great **brute** of a machine.
- It's a **brute** of a soundwave kicking me in the back of my neck.





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10. Char

Kannada : ಕೆಲಸದವಳು, ಚಾಕರಿಯವಳು

Hindi : जलाना

Meaning: partially burn (an object) so as to blacken its surface

Synonyms: scorch, burn, singe

Antonyms : achromatic, exhale, spiny-finned fish, extinguish, hypopigmentation, conserve, whiten

Sentence:

- Their bodies were badly **charred** in the fire.
- She trimmed the **char** from the wicks of the oil lamps.
- Don't **char** the outside of the meat too much.
- The exposed surfaces of the beams may **char** in a fire.
- I lightly **char** fresh asparagus on a hot ridged griddle pan for maximum flavour.
