Major Threats to Biodiversity:


Habitat Loss and Degradation: Deforestation, particularly for large-scale agriculture (e.g., cattle farming in Brazil's Cerrado), continues to be a primary driver of biodiversity loss. Urbanization, industrial development, and unsustainable land use also contribute.

Pollution: Plastic waste, chemical pollutants, contaminating and toxic substances are terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems, with significant impacts on marine life and human health. Air and water pollution remain major concerns.

Policv and Legislation: Strengthening environmental protections, revising wetland rules, and ensuring effective implementation of biodiversity acts are crucial.
