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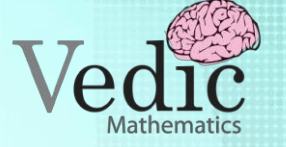
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Biodiversity & Conservation:

World Nature Conservation Day: The upcoming World Nature Conservation Day on July 28, 2025, was a major topic.
