

Defence news

I. India-Specific Defense News:

Indian Army Denies Drone Strikes on ULFA-I Camps in Myanmar: The Indian Army has categorically denied its involvement in any operation that allegedly killed 19 United Liberation Front of Asom-Independent (ULFA-I) cadres, including three top leaders, in Myanmar. ULFA-I claimed that its eastern headquarters in Myanmar's Sagaing region, near the India-Myanmar border, was targeted by over 150 drones from the Indian Army early on July 13. While ULFA-I insists on Indian Army involvement, providing details of the alleged attacks, the Indian Army's Defence PRO stated there are "no inputs" with them on such an operation. Assam Chief Minister also denied state police involvement. Security sources suggest the incident could be internal to Myanmar's ongoing civil war, with various ethnic armed groups involved in frequent clashes.

Indian Army Launches 'Operation SHIVA 2025' for Amarnath Yatra Security: The Indian Army, in close coordination with civil administration and Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), has launched 'Operation SHIVA 2025' to ensure the safe and smooth conduct of the Amarnath Yatra pilgrimage.

Enhanced Security: Over 8,500 troops are deployed along both the northern and southern Yatra routes.

Technological Integration: A robust security architecture includes a Counter-UAS (C-UAS) grid with over 50 systems to neutralize drone threats. continuous UAV missions.

monitoring of Yatra convoys using highresolution PTZ cameras and drone feeds, and multi-agency updates real-time for coordination.

Comprehensive Support: The operation also includes deployment of engineer task forces for bridge construction and disaster mitigation, over 150 doctors and medical personnel with advanced aid stations and a 100-bed hospital, signal companies for communication, EME detachments for technical support, and Bomb Detection & Disposal Squads. Emergency rations and Quick Reaction Teams (QRTs) are also on standby.

DRDO & IAF Successfully Flight-Test Astra Missile with Indigenous Seeker: The Defence Development Research and Organisation (DRDO) and the Indian Air Force (IAF) successfully conducted a flight-test of the Astra Beyond Visual Range Air-to-Air missile (BVRAAM) from a Su-30 Mk-I fighter jet.

Key Achievement: The test validated the missile's indigenous Radio Frequency (RF) seeker, designed and developed by DRDO.

Performance: Two launches against high-speed unmanned aerial targets demonstrated pinpoint accuracy. destroving targets different ranges and aspects.

Significance: This marks a major milestone in India's quest for self-reliance in critical defense technology, enhancing the missile's lethality and reducing dependence on foreign systems. The Astra BVRAAM has a range exceeding 100 km.

Defence Acquisition Council (DAC), chaired by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, accorded Acceptance of Necessity (AoN) for 10 capital acquisition proposals worth approximately ₹1.05 lakh crore.

"Make in India" Focus: All procurements will be made from Indian manufacturers under the 'Buy (Indian-Indigenously Designed Developed and Manufactured)' category.

Key Procurements: Include Armoured Recovery Vehicles. Electronic Warfare Systems, Integrated Common Inventory Management System for the Tri-Services, Surface-to-Air Missiles (reportedly three regiments of Quick Reaction Surface-to-Air Missiles for the Indian Army at ~₹30,000 crore), Moored Mines, Mine Counter Measure Vessels (12 MCMVs at ~₹44,0<mark>00 cr</mark>ore), Super Rapid Gun Mounts, and Submersible Autonomous Vessels. These aim to enhance mobility, air defense, supply chain management, and operational preparedness.

Fifth Fast Patrol Vessel 'Achal' Launched for Indian Coast Guard (June 16, 2025): The Indian Coast Guard launched 'Achal', the fifth Fast Patrol Vessel (FPV) in a series of eight being constructed by Goa Shipyard Ltd (GSL). This vessel, with over 60% indigenous content, further boosts India's "Aatmanirbharta" (selfreliance) in defense manufacturing for maritime security.

II. International Defense News:

US to Send Patriot Missiles to Ukraine; EU to Reimburse: U.S. President Donald Trump announced that the United States will send Patriot air defense missiles to Ukraine, citing their necessity to defend against Russian attacks. He stated that the European Union

would reimburse the U.S. for the cost of thes missiles. This comes as Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy has repeatedly called for more defensive capabilities against ongoing Russian missile and drone attacks.

France to Significantly Increase Defense **Spending:** French President Emmanuel Macron called for a massive boost to France's defense budget, stating that peace in Europe faces a greater threat than at any time since World War II, a clear reference to Russia.

Budget Increase: Macron proposed a 3.5 billion euro increase in 2026, followed by another 3 billion euros in 2027. France's defense budge has already risen sharply under Macron, from 32.2 billion euros in 2017 to 50.5 billion currently, with a projection to reach 67 billion euros by 2030.

Rationale: The move is driven by the changing strategic parameters due to the war in Ukraine, the "durable" threat posed by Russia, and concerns about a diminished U.S. commitment to Europe.

Hundreds of Myanmar Junta Soldiers Flee to **Thailand:** More than 100 Myanmar junta soldiers, along with over 400 civilians, fled into Thailand after ethnic Karen fighters (Karen National Liberation Army - KNLA) overran military bases in eastern Myanmar's Kayin State over the weekend. Thai military disarmed and provided humanitarian aid to the fleeing soldiers and civilians. This highlights the deteriorating security situation and ongoing civil conflict in Myanmar since the 2021 military coup.

NATO-South Korea Cooperation Deepens: NATO and the Republic of Korea (South Korea) are actively enhancing political dialogue and practical cooperation across various security challenges, including cyber defense, arms control, non-proliferation, and capability development. This deepening relationship in the Indo-Pacific is seen as crucial for upholding security and the rules-based international order, particularly in light of challenges posed by North Korea's provocative actions and the increasing links between Euro-Atlantic and Indo-Pacific security.

North Korea Reportedly Supplying Artillery to Russia: South Korean military intelligence authorities have reported that North Korea has consistently supplied Russia with over 12 million rounds of 152-millimeter artillery shells to aid Moscow in its war against Ukraine. North Korea has also reportedly integrated Russianprovided Pantsir air defense systems into its domestic air defense.
