



Defense Procurement & Technology

Defence Acquisition Council (DAC) Approvals: The DAC, headed by the Defence Minister of India, approved 10 capital acquisition proposals worth approximately ₹1.05 lakh crore. These procurements were made under the 'Buy (Indian-Indigenously Designed, Developed and Manufactured, IDDM)' category to promote selfreliance in defense.

Indian Army: The approvals for the Army included Quick Reaction Surface-to-Air Missile (QRSAM) systems and Armoured Recovery Vehicles (ARVs).

Indian Navy: The DAC cleared proposals for 12 Mine Counter Measure Vessels (MCMVs) and other systems to enhance maritime security.

Equine Disease-Free Compartment (EDFC): A significant development was the establishment India's first Equine Disease-Free of Compartment (EDFC) in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. This facility, recognized by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH), will enable Indian sport horses to participate in international competitions, boosting country's equestrian sector.

DRDO Pralay Missile Tests: While the flight tests of the Pralay missile were reported at the end of July, it's worth noting the successful tests of this short-range, surface-to-surface missile, which is designed for tactical battlefield use and can evade enemy interception systems.

Other Notable News

Indian Navy Annual Safety Review: The Indian Navy held its annual safety review on July 5, 2025, to assess and improve safety standards across its fleet.

Legal & International: A court denied bail to promoter of DHFL in a major bank fraud case, and international news included reports on naval drills between India and the Philippines in the South China Sea.






