

Defence news

Indian armed forces have been active in joint military exercises, international cooperation, and humanitarian assistance on September 9, 2025. Here is a summary of the latest defense news.

India's Defence Developments

High-Altitude Combat Diving: The Indian Army's PARA (Special Forces) and the Indian Marine Commandos (MARCOS) concluded a joint scuba and combat diving exercise in Sikkim. Conducted at an altitude of 17,000 feet, the week-long exercise from August 30 to September 5 focused on open-circuit and closed-circuit diving in freezing glacial waters to improve high-altitude operational readiness and inter-service cooperation.

Military Exercises: The 14th edition of the India-Thailand joint military exercise, "MAITREE-XIV," is underway in Meghalaya from September 1 to September 14, 2025. The exercise focuses on counter-terrorism operations.

Humanitarian Assistance: The Indian Army's Western Command has been conducting extensive humanitarian assistance and disaster relief (HADR) operations in flood-affected areas of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, and Jammu & Kashmir since August 26.

Jammu and Kashmir Encounter: An encounter in the Kulgam district of Jammu and Kashmir entered its second day, with two soldiers and two terrorists killed so far. One of the terrorists is believed to be a Pakistani national.

Procurement and Technology: A new book by two Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) officials, "Nuances of Transfer of Technology (TOT)," was launched, discussing procurement reforms and the importance of TOT for India's self-reliance in defense manufacturing.

International Defence News

NATO: The NATO Secretary General, Mr. Mark Rutte, is in the United Kingdom for a meeting of the Ukraine Defence Contact Group.

International Criminal Court: A confirmation of charges hearing for Joseph Kony is scheduled to begin on September 9, 2025, at the International Criminal Court in The Hague. He is being tried in absentia for crimes against humanity and war crimes.

India-New Zealand Consultation: India and New Zealand held Foreign Office Consultations in New Delhi to strengthen bilateral relations, including in the defense and trade sectors.




