Defense news on September 12, 2025, centers India's strategic partnerships technological advancements. A key highlight is the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) receipt of the third General Electric F404-IN20 engine for the Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas Mk1A, which will help meet the Indian Air Force's demand for the jet. This is a critical step toward the delivery of 10 Tejas Mk1A and trainer jets by March 2026. The LCA Tejas Mk1A is designed to replace the IAF's aging MiG-21 fleet.

development Another significant strengthening of India's global defense collaborations. Bharat Forge has signed two international deals. One is Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the UK-based Windracers Limited to localize, deploy, and apply unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) in India. The other is a landmark contract signed by its subsidiary, Kalyani Strategic Systems, with the UAE's GRADEONE for the supply of 155mm howitzer barrels. This is the first such contract between an Indian and Emirati defense firm.

Additionally, the Defence Secretary of India, Rajesh Kumar Singh, emphasized the need for India to project its hard power alongside its soft power. He made these remarks at the Southern Command Defence Tech 2025 seminar (STRIDE 2025), citing geopolitical conflicts and rising nationalism as reasons for this strategic shift.






