

Indian Defence

Operation Sindoor: India's Chief of Defence Staff (CDS), General Anil Chauhan, addressed students in Ranchi, stating that 'Operation Sindoor' signaled a "new kind of warfare" for India. He highlighted the use of precision strikes on long-distance targets at night to avoid civilian casualties. He also emphasized that the Indian armed forces have learned key lessons from the operation to improve preparedness and integration.

Indigenous Development: The Indian Army's Eastern Command is set to host the fourth edition of its flagship defense technology exhibition, East Tech 2025, in Ranchi. The event aims to promote the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' vision by showcasing indigenous defense technologies, including AI, drones, robotics, and advanced firepower platforms.

Defence Procurement: A major procurement proposal for 114 "Made in India" Rafale fighter jets, valued at over ₹2 lakh crore, is under review by the Defence Ministry. This deal, a collaboration between France's Dassault Aviation and Indian firms, follows the Rafale's strong performance during 'Operation Sindoor'.

Pension System Reform: CDS General Anil Chauhan also inaugurated the SPARSH Outreach Programme for defense pensioners in Siliguri. The program, which has onboarded about 31 lakh defense pensioners, is a "Minimum Government, Maximum Governance" reform that streamlines the pension process by crediting payments directly to bank accounts.

International Defence

Saudi Arabia-Pakistan Defence Pact: Saudi Arabia and Pakistan signed a formal "Strategic Mutual Defence Agreement," pledging mutual support in the event of an external aggression. Pakistan's Defence Minister stated that their nuclear program could be made available to Saudi Arabia under this new pact. India's Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) is studying implications of this development, reaffirming its commitment to protecting national interests.

NATO: NATO Secretary General Mark Rutte visited the Volkel Air Base in the Netherlands home to two Royal Netherlands Air Force F-35 squadrons. The visit highlighted the importance of allied cooperation and the readiness of F-35 aircraft for 'Quick Reaction Alert' duties to intercept unidentified aircraft.


