## International News

**US-China Meeting:** US Secretary of State Marco Rubio and Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi are scheduled to hold their first in-person meeting in Malaysia. This comes amid heightened tensions regarding trade, defense, and other issues.

Tariffs: US President Donald Trump announced a 35% tariff on goods imported from Canada, effective August 1st. He also indicated plans for blanket tariffs of 15%-20% on most other trading partners, downplaying concerns about inflation or market impact. This has raised concerns about escalating trade conflicts.

Citizenship Law: Cambodia Amnesty International has condemned a National Assembly-approved amendment Cambodian Constitution that would allow for the revocation of Khmer citizenship, expressing concern that it could be used to crack down on critics and render them stateless.

Ukraine Conflict: Russia has reportedly escalated drone and missile attacks on Ukrainian cities, leading to a three-year high in casualties. civilian Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy stated his country is ready to open all negotiation clusters with the EU and called for a resolution to Hungary's veto membership progress. Ukraine's EU Meanwhile, the US confirmed it will send more weapons to Ukraine via NATO, and France and the UK agreed to reinforce cooperation on their nuclear arsenals.

Middle East: An Israeli airstrike reportedly killed 10 children and 6 adults near a medica center in Gaza, as ceasefire talks continue without an immediate deal.

**Egypt-China Cooperation:** Egypt and China reaffirmed their commitment to strengthening cooperation across various sectors during talks between Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi and Chinese Premier Li Qiang in Cairo.

**Global Oil Consumption:** OPEC announced that global oil consumption is expected to continue rising until at least 2050, projecting an 18.6% increase between 2024 and 2050. This position runs counter to international climate goals.


**Indian Stock Market:** The Indian equity benchmark indices, Nifty50 and BSE Sensex, saw declines due to lower-than-anticipated Q1 results from TCS, heightened trade conflicts following new US tariffs, and concerns over potential Russian sanctions.


