International News

Geopolitical Conflicts & Tensions:

Ukraine Conflict: A Russian missile strike on a Ukrainian training unit killed three servicemen and injured 18. This is the latest in a series of similar attacks on training facilities. (The Hindu)

Israel-Palestine Conflict: high-level international conference on the two-state solution for Israel and Palestine is underway at the UN, with member states calling for a peaceful settlement and implementation of UN resolutions. (UN News, The Hindu)

Cambodia-Thailand Border Conflict: Clashes continue on the Cambodia-Thailand border, with reports of deaths on both sides and thousands of civilians displaced. Cambodia has called for an immediate ceasefire, while Thailand has declared martial law in border districts and launched airstrikes. (Wikipedia)

Syrian Civil War Aftermath: Clashes between pro-government forces and Druze fighters in Suwayda, Syria, have resulted in dozens of deaths and injuries. (Wikipedia)

Red Sea Crisis: Houthi attacks on commercial vessels continue, with one Liberian-flagged ship, the Eternity C, sinking after an attack, causing casualties. Israel has responded with airstrikes on Houthi-controlled (Wikipedia)

International Relations & Trade:

US-India Trade: US President Donald Trump has hinted at imposing a 20-25% tariff on India, citing higher tariffs imposed by India on US goods. He also reiterated his claim of brokering a ceasefire between India and Pakistan, which India has repeatedly refuted. (The Hindu)

Global Challenges & Developments:

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): The High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) concluded, with Member States calling for urgent, coordinated action to accelerate progress on the SDGs. While progress has been made in areas like health and education, nearly half of the targets are advancing too slowly or have regressed, with extreme poverty and climate change remaining major concerns. (United Nations)

Civic Space in El Salvador: El Salvador remains on the Civicus Monitor's watchlist due to repression of human intensified defenders, journalists, and civil society organizations under a prolonged state of emergency. A new "Foreign Agents Law" has been enacted, imposing a 30% tax on foreign funding and granting authorities broad powers to monitor civil society activities. (Civicus Monitor)

Global Economy: The IMF released its July 2025 World Economic Outlook Update. (IMF)

Climate Change: Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs) have threatened Himalayan regions, causing damage and power supply issues, attributed to rising temperatures. (GKToday)


