International News

Israel-Gaza Conflict

Five Al Jazeera journalists were killed in an Israeli strike near Gaza City. The IDF claims one of the correspondents was a "terrorist cell leader in Hamas."

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu outlined five principles to end the war, stating that Hamas still has thousands of armed terrorists and that "Gazans are begging us to be freed." He also reiterated that war could end immediately if Hamas lays down arms and releases all hostages.

Tens of thousands protested Netanyahu's plan, with families of hostages demanding a ceasefire.

Ukraine-Russia Relations

Ukrainian forces launched drone attacks on several Russian oblasts, killing at least two people in Tula. A large fire was also reported at an oil refinery in Sochi following a Ukrainian drone attack.

Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva and Russian President Vladimir Putin discussed the Ukraine conflict and planned a BRICS meeting to weigh a joint response to tariffs proposed by Donald Trump.

Russia and Ukraine are holding firm on their demands ahead of a planned summit between Putin and Trump.

Global Economic and Political Issues

U.S. President Donald Trump's administration has imposed new tariffs on imports from India, citing India's purchase of Russian oil as a reason.

The Indian Ministry of External Affairs is set to brief a parliamentary committee on the issue, stating that the tariffs are based on "flawed assumptions."

Brazil's President Lula and Russia's President Putin are planning a BRICS meeting to discuss a joint response to these tariffs.

Other International News

A magnitude 6.1 earthquake struck western Turkey, killing at least one person and injuring 29.

A British F-35B fighter jet made an emergency landing at a Japanese airport due to a mechanical issue.

Thai soldiers were injured by a landmine near the Cambodian border, just days after a ceasefire was reached between the two countries.

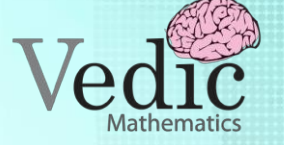
