International News

US-China Relations:

China seeks "healthy development" of trade ties: China's Commerce Minister Wang Wentao stated that China aims to bring commercial ties with the U.S. back to a state of healthy and sustainable development. He emphasized that a "forced decoupling" is impossible and that both sides remain important economic partners, calling for "equal dialogue and consultations."

US tariffs on China: The current overall tariff level imposed by the U.S. on China remains "still high" at 53.6%. China reiterated that it does not want a trade war but is not afraid of one.

Trade deal progress: US President Donald Trump stated that a trade deal with China is nearing completion, with China expected to supply rare earths and the U.S. to allow students.

Middle East & Conflict Zones:

US on Israeli strikes in Syria: The US State Department stated it did not support recent Israeli strikes in Syria, expressing displeasure and actively engaging with both Israel and Syria to de-escalate tensions and seek a lasting agreement.

Attack on Gaza's Catholic Church: Israeli strikes reportedly hit the Church of the Holy Family in Gaza, the only remaining Catholic church, killing three people and injuring nine, including the priest. The Israel Defense Forces are reviewing the incident.

Slovenia to ban Israeli ministers: Slovenia plans to declare Israeli Ministers Itamar Ben-Gvir and Bezalel Smotrich "persona non grata" due to their role in the "unbearable situation" in Gaza, becoming the first EU member state to do so.

Russia-Ukraine ceasefire: The White House warned Russia would face "very steep" tariffs if it does not agree to a ceasefire with Ukraine within 50 days.

New PM in Ukraine: Ukraine's parliament voted to approve Yulia Svyrydenko's nomination as the country's new prime minister.

Iraq shopping mall fire: Nearly 50 people were killed and injured in a shopping center fire in eastern Iraq.

Global Politics & Diplomacy:


US House approves \$9 billion cut to public **broadcasting and foreign aid:** The US House of Representatives gave final approval President Trump's request to claw back about \$9 billion from public broadcasting and foreign aid programs.

India welcomes US designation of TRF as terrorist outfit: India welcomed the U.S. designating The Resistance Front (TRF), a Lashkar-e-Toiba (LeT) proxy, as a global terrorist organization, describing it as a "strong affirmation" of India-U.S. counter-terrorism cooperation.

UK-Germany Friendship Treaty: The UK and Germany signed a landmark "Friendship and Cooperation Treaty" aimed at strengthening bilateral ties across defense, foreign policy, economic cooperation, and migration.


