## International News

#### Geopolitical & Military Developments:

Russia-Ukraine Conflict: Russia has accused Ukraine of a drone strike on the Kursk nuclear power station, which allegedly damaged a transformer and reduced capacity at one reactor. The incident reportedly occurred on Ukraine's Independence Day. In a separate development, Ukraine's President Zelenskyy has expressed a desire for direct talks with Russian President Putin.

Israel-Gaza & Yemen Conflicts: A UN-backed report has officially declared a famine in the Gaza Governorate, attributing the situation to actions taken by the Israeli government. Israel, however, disputes this report. Meanwhile, Israel has conducted airstrikes on Yemen's capital, Sanaa, targeting Houthi rebels. The Houthis claim the strikes killed six people and injured dozens more.

**US-China Tensions:** China has condemned the United States for what it calls "harassment" of Chinese students, citing interrogations and maltreatment at US borders.

### **Diplomatic & Economic News:**

**International Postal Services:** Several countries. including India, have temporarily suspended most international postal services to the United States. This action is in response to a new US executive order that withdraws the duty-free exemption for low-value goods, making all goods, regardless of value, subject to customs duties.

**US Tariffs:** The US has imposed new secondary tariffs on India. US Vice President ID Vance stated in an interview that these tariffs are part of a strategy to exert economic pressure on India to force Russia to end the war in Ukraine. In response, India's envoy to Russia stated that India will continue to purchase oil from wherever it gets the "best deal."

Japan-South Korea Relations: The leaders of Japan and South Korea have pledged closer ties and issued their first joint statement in 17 years. They have agreed to deepen cooperation in technology and trade and to form a joint task force to address the challenges of aging populations and declining birth rates.

### **Other Major Stories:**

SpaceX Starship: Elon Musk's SpaceX has scrubbed the tenth test flight of its Starship rocket due to a ground systems glitch.


