International News

Political and Diplomatic Events:

Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO)

Summit: A high-profile SCO summit is taking place in Tianjin, China. The meeting is the largest in the organization's history, with 20 world leaders, including Chinese President Xi Jinping, Russian President Vladimir Putin, and Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in attendance. 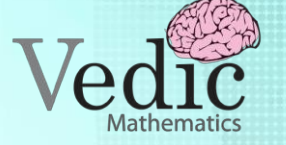
