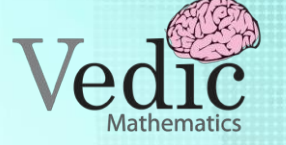

International News

Middle East Conflict

Israel Strikes Hamas in Qatar: Israel conducted an airstrike on a Hamas residential headquarters in Doha, Qatar, killing six people. The strike did not kill any members of the Hamas negotiating team who were participating in peace talks to end the war in Gaza.

Global Condemnation of Strike: The attack provoked global outrage and condemnation from Qatar, the United Nations, European leaders, Turkey, and Canada. U.S. President Donald Trump and French and UK officials all distanced themselves from the action, with some U.S. lawmakers calling for an end to military aid to Israel.

Gaza Evacuation Order: In a separate development, the Israeli military dropped leaflets on Gaza City, ordering its residents to evacuate immediately to a "humanitarian zone" in the south ahead of a major ground offensive.

Political and Social Events

Nepal Prime Minister Resigns: Nepal Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli resigned amid escalating anti-corruption protests in the capital, Kathmandu. The protests, which were initially triggered by a social media ban, have turned violent, with demonstrators setting fire to the parliament building. The Nepali Army has since taken charge of security to restore order.

France Appoints New Prime Minister: French President Emmanuel Macron named Sébastien Lecornu as his new prime minister. Lecornu replaces François Bayrou, who lost a no-confidence vote over a proposed austerity budget.

Thailand Court Jails Former Premier: Thailand's top court sentenced former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra to one year in prison, ruling that the time he spent in a luxury hospital suite did not count as jail time for his previous conviction.

Science and Technology

Asteroid Flyby: NASA confirmed that a large asteroid, 2025 QV9, made a close but harmless flyby of Earth on September 10. The asteroid, roughly the size of an airplane, passed at a distance of approximately 1.25 million miles.

Munich Auto Show: Chinese and European automakers are competing for market share at the Munich auto show. Chinese electric car manufacturers, like BYD and Hongqi, announced plans to expand local production and sales in Europe, prompting European carmakers like Renault to seek more competitive pricing strategies.

Other Notable Events

World Suicide Prevention Day: September 10, 2025, is recognized as World Suicide Prevention Day by the International Association for Suicide Prevention (IASP) and the World Health Organization (WHO) to raise awareness about preventing suicide.

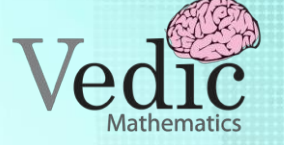

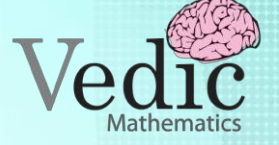
