International News

North America

United States: New York commemorated the 24th anniversary of the 9/11 attacks with solemn remembrance. U.S. President Donald Trump commented on new tariffs, stating, "America first does not mean India last. We want strong ties with our friends in Delhi."

Mexico: A massive gas tanker blast in Mexico City resulted in three deaths and 70 injuries. Mexico also raised import duties on Asian goods to counter U.S. trade pressure.

Asia

South Korea: Seoul identified Kim Jong Un's daughter, Ju Ae, as the "likely successor" to lead North Korea. The South Korean President warned that without visa reforms, businesses would hesitate to invest in the U.S. South Korea and the U.S. are also working on a new visa system for migrant workers.

Nepal: Gen Z-led protests in Nepal turned violent, leading to the ouster of the prime minister. Prohibition orders were extended as the political vacuum deepened, with the President urging restraint. Indian pilgrims and tourists remained trapped along the Nepal-China border.

Philippines: The Philippines rejected a Chinese proposal for a wildlife reserve at a disputed shoal in the South China Sea.

Thailand: The ruling Pheu Thai Party moved to dissolve parliament, setting up a new election after the prime minister was dismissed from office.

Middle East & Europe

Gaza/Middle East: Tensions remained high in the region with an Israeli strike on senior Hamas leaders in Qatar being widely condemned as a violation of sovereignty that jeopardized ceasefire negotiations. An Israeli airstrike in Gaza City killed at least 65 people.

Russia/Ukraine: Russia fired over 500 drones and two dozen missiles at Ukraine, targeting central and western regions and wounding several people. In response, Poland scrambled fighter jets and placed air defenses on maximum readiness.

Brazil: Brazil's Supreme Court sentenced former President Jair Bolsonaro to over 27 years in prison for his role in a coup attempt to overturn the 2022 election results.

Other Major Events

Brazil: Brazil's former president Jair Bolsonaro was sentenced to 27 years in prison for an attempted coup.

Australia: Australia's Foreign Minister Penny Wong condemned Israeli strikes on Qatar as sovereignty. violation of Australia announced a significant investment in a new fleet of autonomous undersea vehicles.

United Kingdom: The House of Lords debated the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill, which would allow for assisted death under certain conditions.
