Nepal Appoints First Female Prime Minister:

Former Chief Justice Sushila Karki was sworn in as Nepal's interim Prime Minister, following a period of political turmoil and violent protests. Her appointment comes after the dissolution of the previous government.

Poland Accuses Russia of Airspace Violation:

Trade Tensions and Diplomacy:

a U.S. envoy-designate stated that ending India's Russian oil imports is a top priority.

U.S. Shooting Investigation: U.S. authorities have arrested 22-year-old Tyler Robinson, the suspect in the killing of conservative activist Charlie Kirk, after a family member helped to turn him in.

Tragedy in Congo: At least 193 passengers were killed in two separate boat accidents in the northwestern part of the Democratic Republic of Congo.

UN General Assembly Endorses Two-State Solution for Palestine:

The UN General Assembly has approved a New York manifesto supporting a peaceful two-state solution to the Palestine problem, with India and 142 other countries in support.

Koala Vaccine Approved: Australia has approved the first-ever vaccine to protect koalas from the chlamydia outbreak, a move lauded by conservation groups.

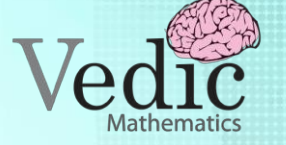
