Geopolitical and Diplomatic Developments

U.S. Vetoes UN Resolution on Gaza: The United States vetoed a UN Security Council resolution that called for an immediate, unconditional, and permanent ceasefire in Gaza and the immediate release of all hostages. The draft resolution was put forward by the council's 10 non-permanent members.

Gaza Conflict Escalates: Israel reportedly launched a major ground assault on Gaza City, accompanied by air and naval bombardments. Reports from Gaza health officials indicated significant casualties. The European Commi<mark>ssi</mark>on proposed suspending its trade agreement with Israel and sanctioning certain Israeli officials and Hamas members in response to the conflict.


