This jump is a result of strong demand for domestic air travel in India and rapid capacity addition by airlines.

The missile is specifically designed to target and destroy large naval vessels and other high-value maritime assets. It is powered by a liquid direct-flow air-breathing jet engine with four air intakes, enabling sustained high-speed flight. The missile can travel at speeds of approximately Mach 2.5 to Mach 3, making it very difficult for enemy air defense systems to intercept.
