National News

Political & Governance:

Emergency-Era MISA Files to be Made Public: The Delhi government is reportedly planning to make public several confidential documents related to the Maintenance of Internal Security Act (MISA), which was widely used during the (1975-1977)Emergency for detention without trial. These documents, retrieved during the digitization of archival records, include details of arrested activists and leaders.

BJP Protest Disrupts Ex-Tripura CM's Meeting: A meeting addressed by former Tripura Chief Minister and senior CPM leader Manik Sarkar in South Tripura's Chottakhola was disrupted by a group of BJP supporters. The BJP activists raised slogans against Sarkar's alleged failures during his tenure, including the Rose Valley chit fund scam, leading to the meeting being called off.

Economy & Finance:

Indian Markets Decline: Benchmark indices Sensex and Nifty opened in the red, dragged down by IT stocks and foreign fund outflows. Analysts are watching for a potential US-India trade deal, with expectations of a 20% tariff rate for India, which could provide a sentimental boost to the market.

Rupee Declines Against US Dollar: The Indian Rupee fell 17 paise to 85.97 against the US dollar in early trade, amid a strengthening greenback and FII outflows. Uncertainties over new US trade tariffs were cited as a factor.

India's Growth Cycle Bottoming Out: A report by HSBC Mutual Fund suggests that India's economic growth cycle may be bottoming out supported by factors like the interest rate and liquidity cycle, declining crude oil prices, and a forecast of a normal monsoon.


Social & Infrastructure:
