National News

1. Foreign Policy & Trade:

The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) briefed a Parliamentary Committee on the new U.S. tariffs on Indian goods.

The MEA officials stated that the tariffs, imposed by the Trump administration, are based on "flawed assumptions" and that India is being pulled into a geopolitical tug-of-war.

India will highlight its commitment to constructive engagement with the U.S. and emphasize the bipartisan nature relationship.

Concurrently, India is holding meetings with officials from the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) to review the ASEAN-India Trade in Goods Agreement (AITIGA) as it seeks to shore up other trade negotiations in the wake of the new tariffs.

2. Infrastructure and Development:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the long-awaited "Yellow Line" of the Bengaluru Metro, which is expected to ease traffic congestion in the city's IT hub.

He also flagged off a new Vande Bharat Express train service between Bengaluru and Belagavi.

In Uttarakhand, the Indian Army constructed a 90-foot Bailey bridge in the cloudburst-affected Dharali area to restore connectivity and facilitate rescue and relief operations.

3. Government and Politics:

The Union Ministry of Home Affairs informed the Jammu and Kashmir High Court that the Lieutenant-Governor of the Union Territory can nominate five members to the J&K Legislative Assembly without the "aid and advice" of the elected government.

The INDIA bloc MPs are planning a protest march to the Election Commission of India (ECI) regarding headquarters alleged electoral malpractices. Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge is hosting a dinner to formulate a common strategy on the issue.

The Indian government withdrew the Income Tax Bill, 2025, and is scheduled to reintroduce an amended version in Parliament incorporating stakeholder feedback.

4. Sports:

Indian all-rounder Hardik Pandya is undergoing a fitness assessment at the National Cricket Academy (NCA) in Bengaluru ahead of the Asia Cup 2025 squad selection.

T20I captain Suryakumar Yadav is also at the NCA, continuing his recovery from sports hernia surgery and is expected to need another week to regain full fitness.

The Asia Cup is set to be held from September 9 to 28 in the UAE, with India and Pakistan potentially facing each other up to three times.






