Prime Minister's Engagements: Prime Minister Narendra Modi is on a two-day visit to Gujarat to inaugurate several development projects worth over Rs 5,400 crore. 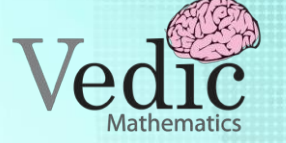
